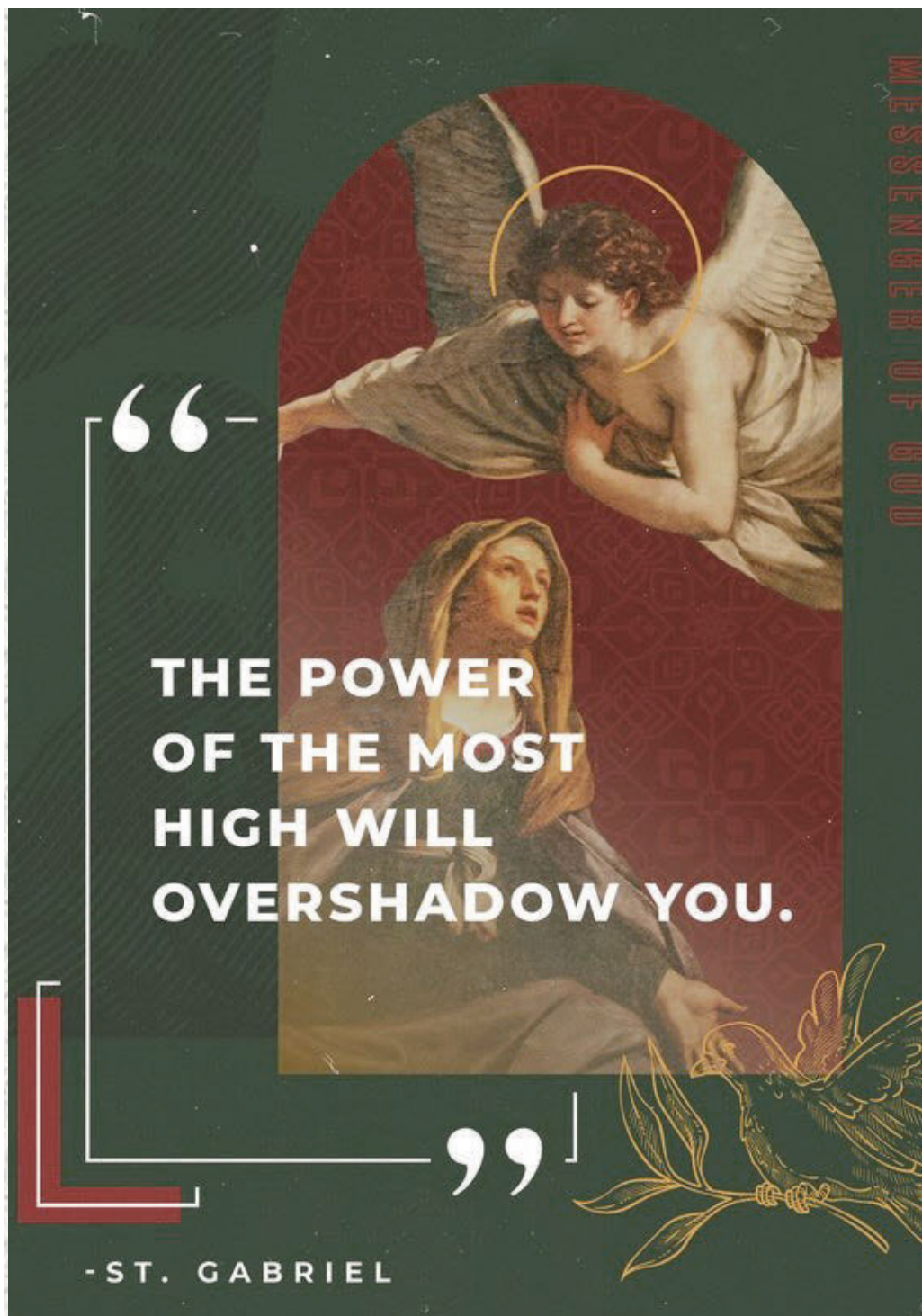

Dear Cathedral and St. Mary Mission Families,

This Sunday we celebrate as the Fourth Sunday of Advent, but quickly move to celebrating the Vigil Mass of Christmas at 5 p.m. and Midnight Mass Sunday evening, and then Christmas day Masses at the Cathedral 8:00am and 10:00am and at St. Mary's on Christmas Day at 10:30am. It makes for the shortest Fourth Week of Advent! Thank you to all working to decorate our churches a bit ahead of time as needed.

We had a beautiful Mass on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe when bishop John presided and prayed the Mass mostly in Spanish. Thanks to others who read the Scriptures and sung hymns in Spanish, too, with the Choir's assistance. The potluck supper afterward offered good fellowship!

December 31st we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. It will lead us into the New Year's Eve and a special time of prayer: We are planning for this time in which to thank the Lord for the blessings of 2023 and to welcome His guiding us into 2024. We will start with a Holy Hour at 11p.m. on December 31st with Rosary and song. Then we'll celebrate Mass to welcome the New Year and Honor Our Lady, the Mother of God, with a midnight Mass. Then we'll enjoy some food and refreshments. All are welcome to join in this special time—You can sign up on the bulletin board so we can plan for food...
