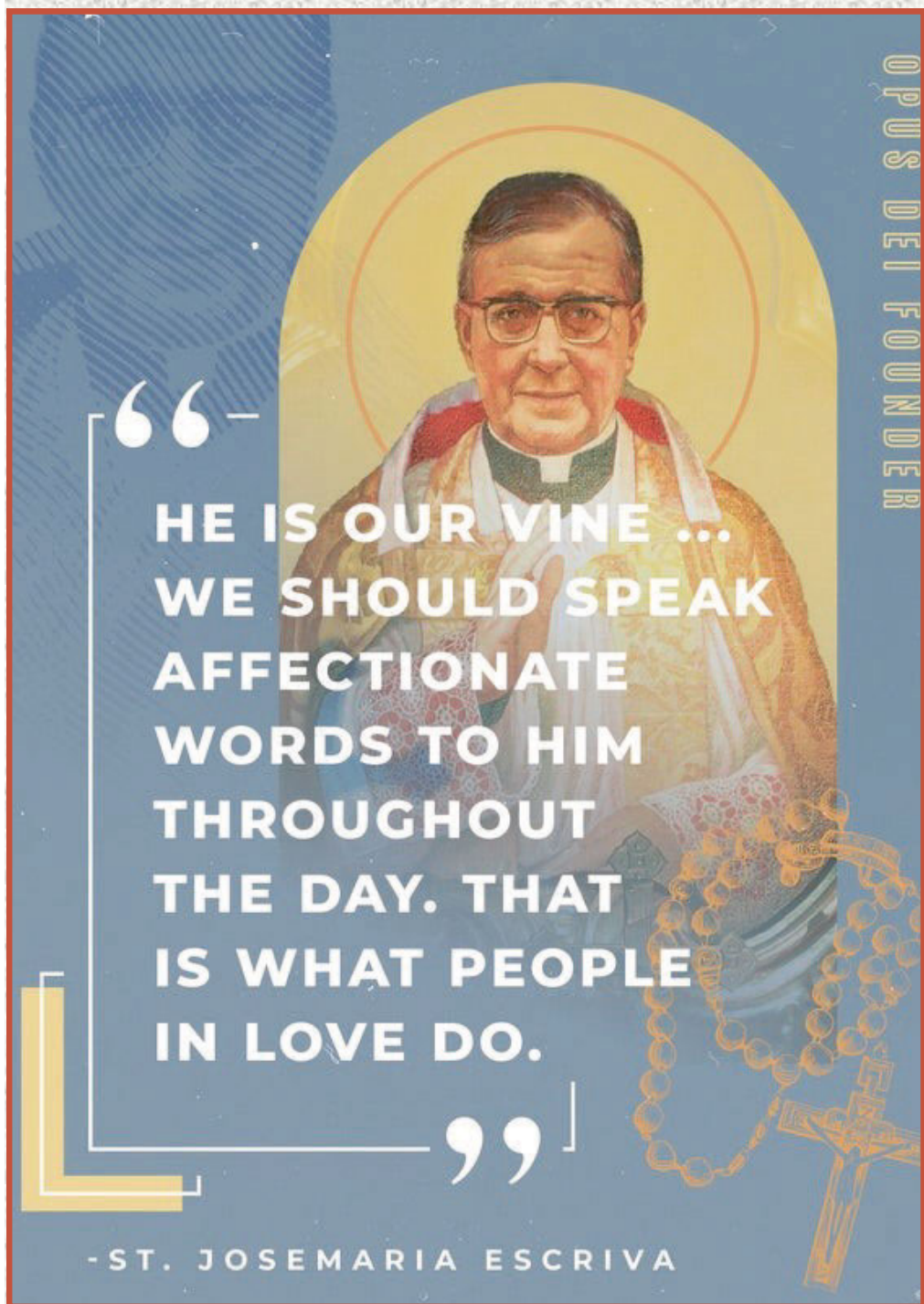

It's always an enriching time of prayer, talks, Masses, confession, and fellowship. I will be back to the parish for the First Communion Mass on May 5th.

Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit, because without me you can do nothing.

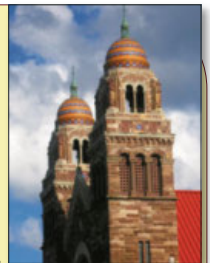

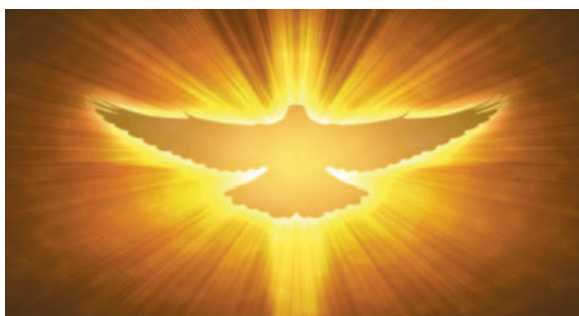

Thoughts from the Newly Confirmed

What really brought me back to the Church, OCIA, and the faith altogether was an encounter I had with Jesus. I was going through a dark season in my life. I tried therapy, eastern meditation, and reading, but I could not shake the despair I was experiencing. One night as I was in my room and not knowing what to do. I turned to Jesus. On the other side of the wall was a Crucifix that my daughter received for her 1st Communion and Confirmation. As I looked toward the wall directly at the Crucifix, I gave all my suffering to Jesus at that moment. I felt warmth come through my chest. This is all I could feel and knew what it was. It was the love Jesus had for me and I had for Him. That moment has changed my life forever.

I was baptized Catholic and now looking back through the years I always talked to God. God just wasn't in the forefront of my life. At the moment that Love entered my heart I just knew I wanted to read the Bible and find fellowship. This led me to choosing the Catholic Church again by getting Confirmed and learning as much as I can. One of the things I love is that you never stop learning. With the scriptures and the church's guidance my life has been changed for the better. I feel like I've been pulled away from the concerns of the world to be fulfilled with God the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Any doubts of faith are always proved to be wrong with more research. I can never not believe because Jesus filled my heart with Love and I can never deny it. I feel the gifts every day that God has given me. I feel so blessed!

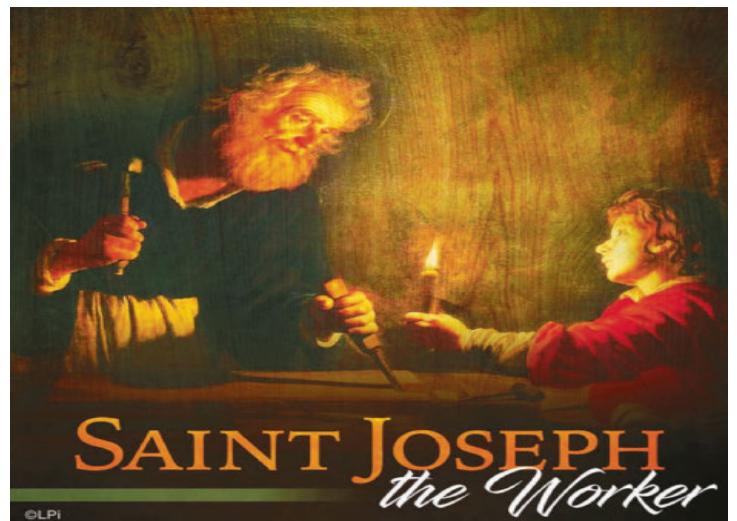
