

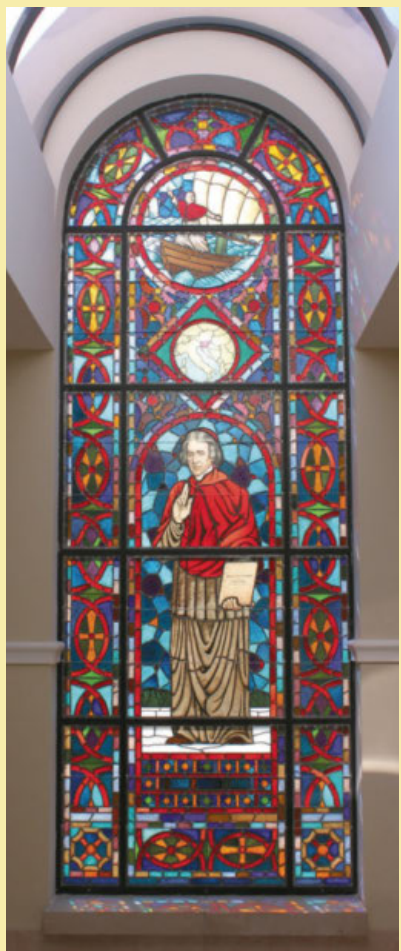

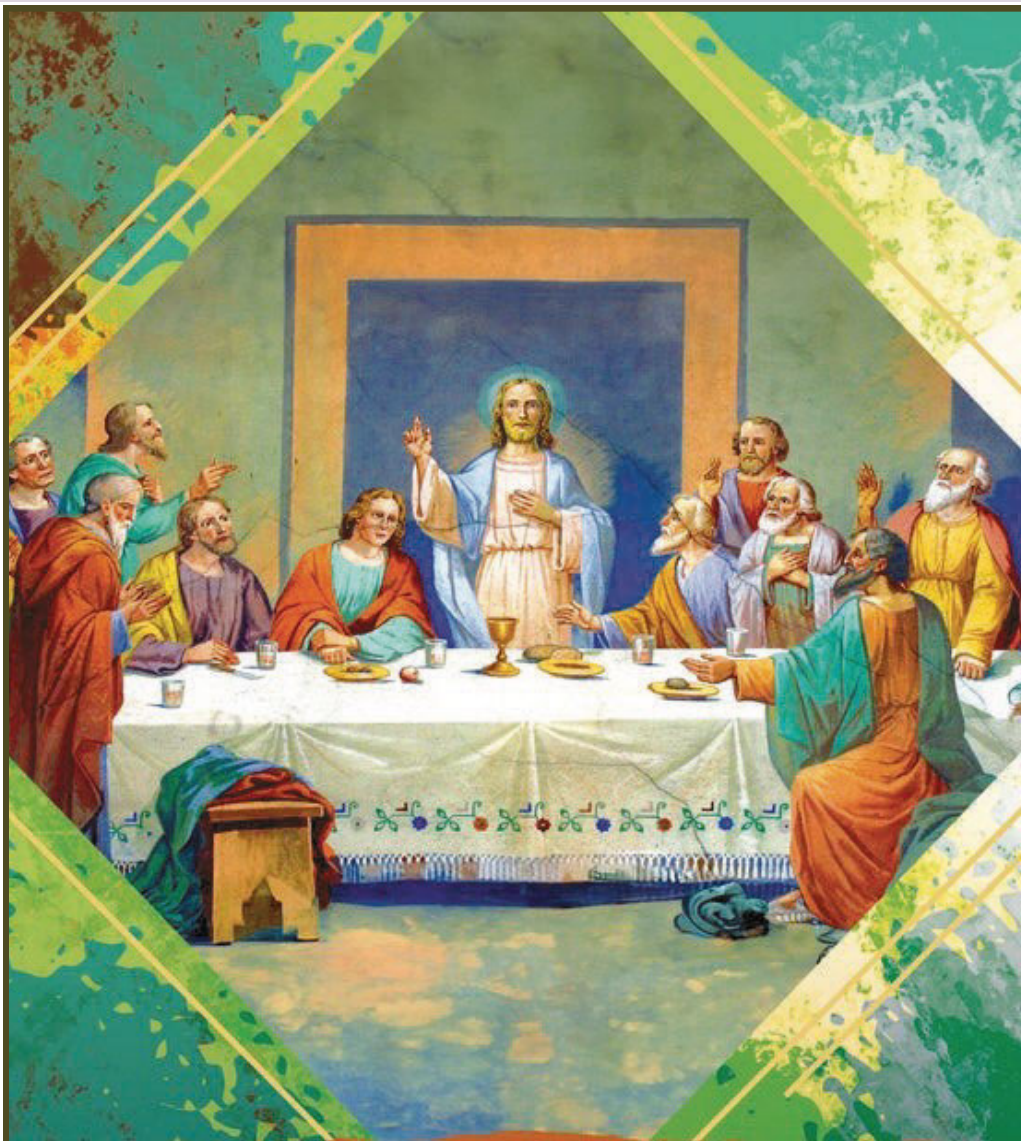

Dear Cathedral and St. Mary Mission families,

This weekend we celebrate the great Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). While we celebrate this amazing gift with every Mass, this Solemnity calls us to a renewed appreciation for Our Lord offering Himself to us and remaining with us in the Holy Eucharist. He gives us His real Presence as the Source and Summit of our Catholic faith, not just a symbol, but His Real Presence abiding with us sacramentally.

We will make a public witness of our gratitude for the Holy Eucharist in making a Eucharistic Procession on Sunday, June 2nd following the 10:30 a.m. Mass. A bus will be at the Cathedral to pick up anyone and bring them to St. Michael Parish where the procession will

begin. We'll walk from St. Michael's to the Cathedral, carrying the Blessed Sacrament with prayer and song. We'll conclude with Benediction and then have a Lunch and fellowship in our courtyard. See the note in this bulletin about bringing a food dish to share if you like... all are welcome!

Corpus Christi Sunday

On the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread, when they sacrificed the Passover lamb, Jesus' disciples said to him, "Where do you want us to go and prepare for you to eat the Passover?"

He sent two of his disciples and said to them, "Go into the city and a man will meet you, carrying a jar of water. Follow him. Wherever he enters, say to the master of the house, The Teacher says, "Where is my guest room where I may eat the Passover with my disciples?"

Then he will show you a large upper room furnished and ready. Make the preparations for us there." The disciples then went off, entered the city, and found it just as he had told them; and they prepared the Passover.

While they were eating, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, gave it to them, and said, "Take it; this is my body."

Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them,

"This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many. Amen, I say to you, I shall not drink again the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the kingdom of God." Then, after singing a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives.

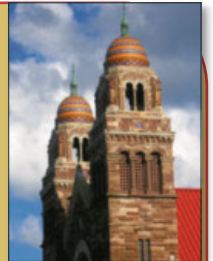

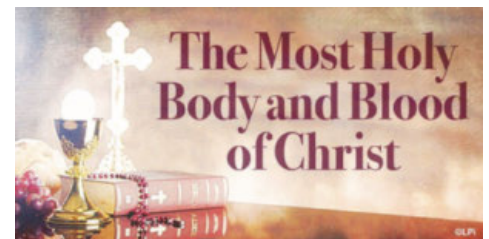
