



Dear Cathedral and St. Mary Mission families,

This weekend we celebrate the great <u>Solemnity of the</u> <u>Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ</u> (Corpus Christi). While we celebrate this amazing gift with every Mass, this Solemnity calls us to a renewed appreciation for Our Lord offering Himself to us and remaining with us in the Holy Eucharist. He gives us His real Presence as the Source and Summit of our Catholic faith, not just a symbol, but His Real Presence abiding with us sacramentally.

We will make a public witness of our gratitude for the Holy Eucharist in making a Eucharistic Procession on Sunday, June 2nd following the 10:30 a.m. Mass. A bus will be at the Cathedral to pick up anyone and bring them to St. Michael Parish where the procession will begin. We'll walk from St. Michael's to the Cathedral, carrying the Blessed Sacrament with prayer and song. We'll conclude with Benediction and then have a Lunch and fellowship in our courtyard.
