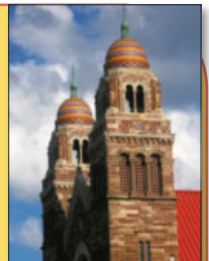

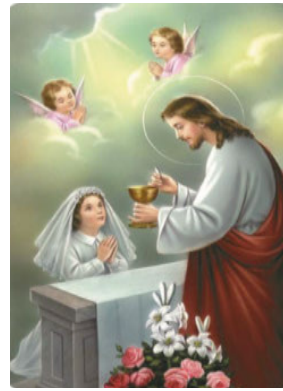

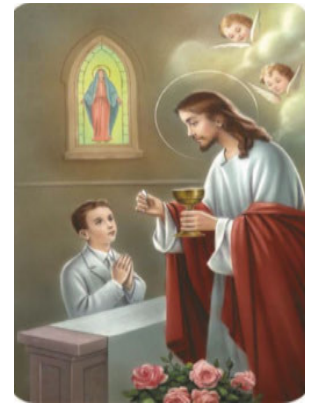
Novena to the Holy Spirit starts on May 10th

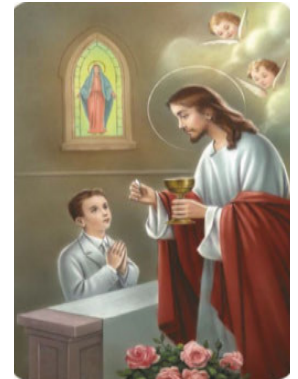

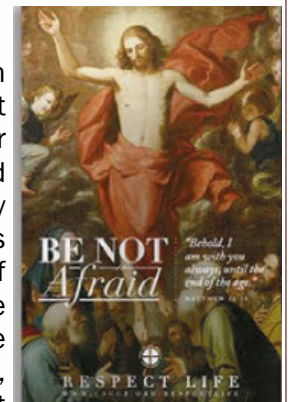


