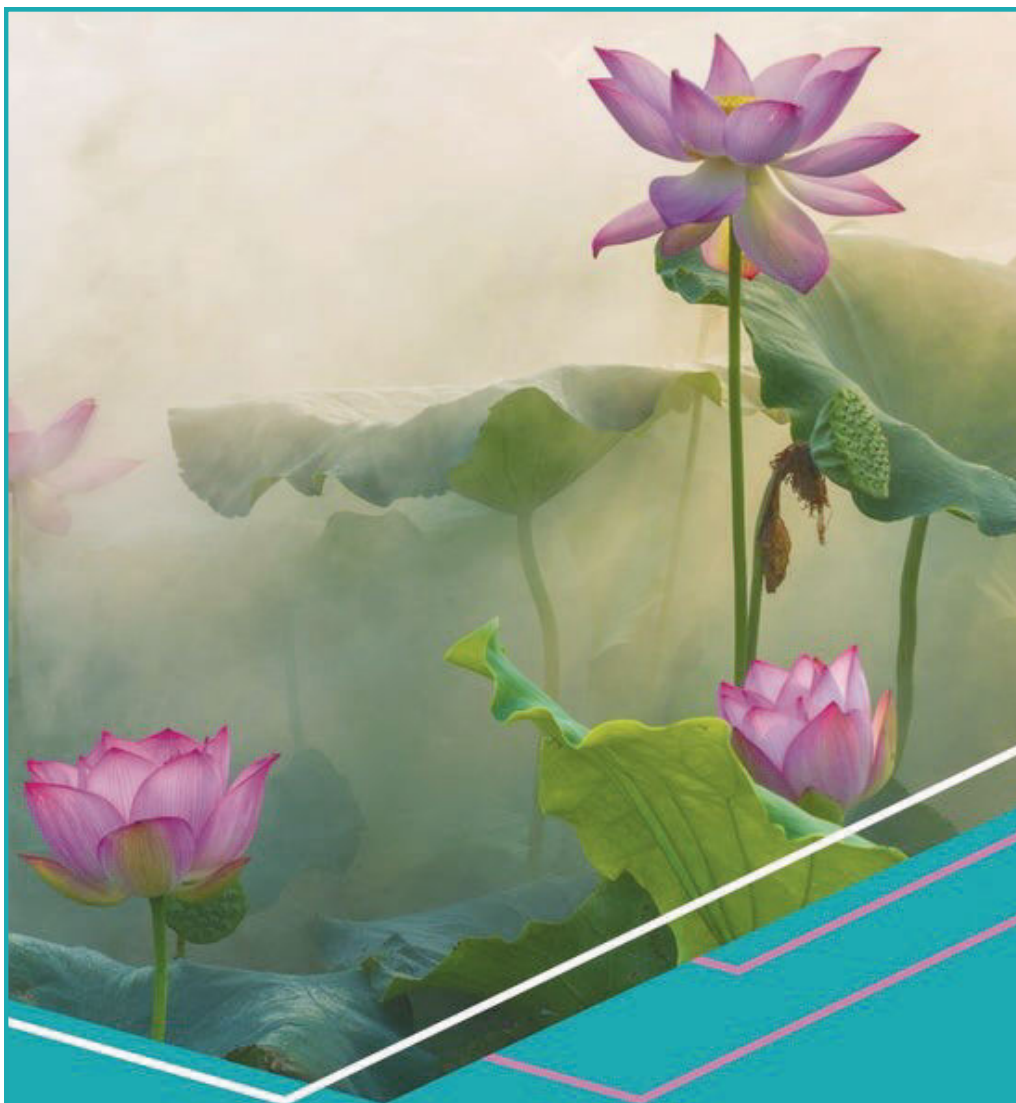

float featuring the Ampe Family, who were named Family of the Year for our State!

You may have noticed work being done on the Baraga Chapel. Repairs were made to stop water leakage occurring around the skylight. Short term repairs will be done to allow use of the Chapel, while still preparing for the final roof construction and power-washing of the exterior stone. Thanks for your patience!

At the same time, Fr. Matthew will be preparing to move for his new assignment in Sault Ste. Marie and Fr. Vinoy will begin serving fully as Associate Pastor here. 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

When Jesus had crossed again in the boat to the other side, a large crowd gathered around him, and he stayed close to the sea. One of the synagogue officials, named Jairus, came forward. Seeing him he fell at his feet and pleaded earnestly with him, saying, "My daughter is at the point of death. Please, come lay your hands on her that she may get well and live." He went off with him, and a large crowd followed him and pressed upon him.

While he was still speaking, people from the synagogue official's house arrived and said, "Your daughter has died; why trouble the teacher any longer?" Disregarding the message that was reported, Jesus said to the synagogue official, "Do not be afraid; just have faith." He did not allow anyone to accompany him inside except Peter, James, and John, the brother of James. When they arrived at the house of the synagogue official, he caught sight of a commotion, people weeping and wailing loudly. So he went in and said to them, "Why this commotion and weeping? The child is not dead but asleep." And they ridiculed him. Then he put them all out. He took along the child's father and mother and those who were with him and entered the room where the child was. He took the child by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum," which means, "Little girl, I say to you, arise!" The girl, a child of twelve, arose immediately and walked around. At that they were utterly astounded. He gave strict orders that no one should know this and said that she should be given something to eat.

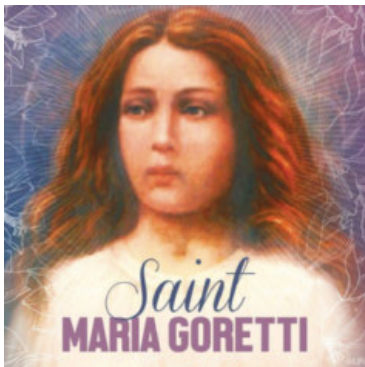

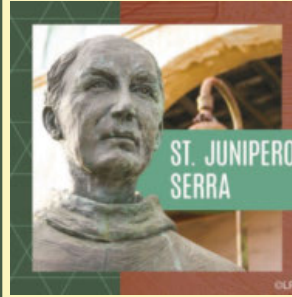

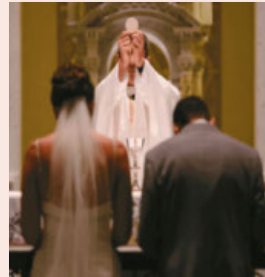

Although far from the battlefield, Baraga's diocese was affected by the Civil War. The rising prices of commodities, decreased purchasing power of the dollar and many of the able-bodied men had left to join the colors; some of them returned home maimed. Donations were fewer and smaller than before and his needs were greater.

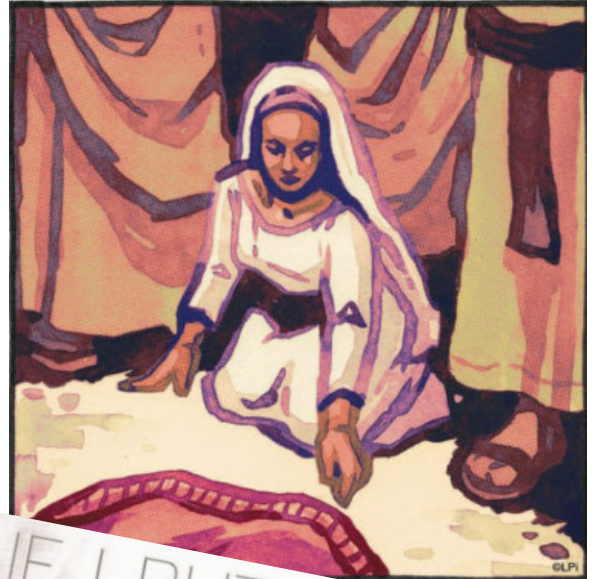

This week, please join with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in praying for the healing of all those who are ill and especially those who have no one to pray for them.

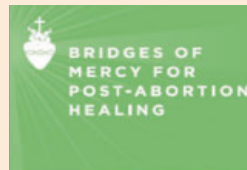
