## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations!

Happy 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time! In Luke Chapter 11, the Gospel for this Sunday, Jesus gives us a series of teachings on prayer. After teaching his disciples the Our Father as a model of prayer, he gives a description of prayer; prayer that is shameless and persistent. Our prayer habits should follow these guidelines. The Saints provide wisdom concerning prayer as well. When asked what prayer is, St. Therese of Lisieux answered: "For me, prayer is a surge of the heart; it is a simple look turned toward heaven. It is a cry of recognition and of love, embracing both trial and joy." Prayer is ultimately a gift from God.



### 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples." He said to them, "When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test."

And he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend to whom he goes at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived at my house from a journey and I have nothing to offer him,' and he says in reply from within, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been locked and my children and I are already in bed. I cannot get up to give you anything.' I tell you, if he does not get up to give the visitor the loaves because of their friendship, he will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence.

"And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

Luke 11:1-13

Both the choir loft and belltower projects are underway. The Grateful for God's Mercies (GFGM) capital campaign is projected to raise nearly \$1.5 million.
