## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations!

This week we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which is a Holy Day of obligation. The Mass times at St. Peter's are Thursday (Vigil), August 14 at 5:30pm and Friday, August 15 at 8:00am and 5:30pm. At St Mary's in Big Bay, Mass is on August 15 at 5:30pm.

Happy 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time! In our second reading we encounter a rich reflection on the nature of Faith: "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). In the encyclical "The Light of Faith", Pope Francis reflects that "There is an urgent need to see once again that faith is a light, for once the flame of faith dies out, all other lights begin to dim. The light of faith is unique, since it is capable of illuminating every aspect of human existence. A light this powerful cannot come from ourselves but from a more primordial source: in a word, it must come from God. Faith is born of an encounter with the living God who calls us and

reveals his love, a love which precedes us and upon which we can lean for security and for building our lives. Transformed by this love, we gain fresh vision, new eyes to see; we realize that it contains a great promise of fulfilment, and that a vision of the future opens up before us. Faith, received from God as a supernatural gift, becomes a light for our way, guiding our journey through time."

Both the choir loft and belltower projects are underway. The Grateful for God's Mercies (GFGM) capital campaign is projected to raise nearly \$1.5 million. The funds have provided our Cathedral with an updated sanctuary and new tabernacle, new boilers, roof repair for the Baraga chapel, AC for the parish office, and partially paid for the sewer pipe repair and north rectory basement wall waterproofing. Thank you for your donations in support of this important and necessary work. Amen, I say to you, he will gird himself, have the servants recline at table, and proceed to wait on them.


And should he come in the second or third watch and find them prepared in this way, blessed are those servants.

### St. Mary Mission History, cont'd from Aug. 3rd:

The Growth of St. Mary's cannot be told without mentioning Philip Aird, Sr., fondly referred to as the "Father of St. Mary's." When he arrived in Big Bay on March 25th, 1912, as manager of the company store, his first thoughts were about Mass and instruction for his large and growing family arriving soon from Antigo, Wisconsin. He asked a couple of Frenchmen who told him that a priest had been there six or seven months ago. Something needed to be done! A month later, Phil went to Marquette to meet his family coming in from Wisconsin. He noticed St. John's Church. He went in and asked to meet the priest, Father Jodocy. Father told him that he was so busy he didn't have time to get to Big Bay, he also said that when he did send a priest, no one would offer him a meal or a bed. Phil assured him that if a priest was sent, his home would be the priest's home. To be continued...


