





Greetings and Salutations!

Happy 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time! The "active duty" priests will be away this coming week from **Sept 15-18** for the annual convocation of priests. 8:00am Mass will continue as scheduled; however, Tues & Wed **5:15pm** Masses on Sept 16 & 17 are **canceled**.

Here is some information about upcoming faith formation opportunities at St. Peter Cathedral:

Sept 21st is the first day of class for all age groups. Regular faith formation classes for grades Kindergarten-8th are Sunday mornings from 9:00-10:15am. For our High Schoolers, the Upper Room gatherings will be held on Sundays from 6:00-7:30pm.

For adults seeking to become Catholic, classes begin on Thursday, **October 16th** at 7:00 pm. It is known as the Order of Christian Initiation for Adults, or **OCIA**. If you are interested, or you know someone who is, please contact me at boman@stpetercathedral.org.

On **November 13th**, we will host the theologian, Dr. Daniel Keating, PhD. Dr. Keating is Professor of Theology at Sacred Heart Major Seminary where he teaches on the Church Fathers, Ecumenism, and the New Evangelization. For side dishes and desserts, please bring a dish to pass. This is an event for the entire family.





St. Mary Mission History, cont'd from Aug. 31st:

The ladies of the congregation decided to organize activities to raise money for a Church. They gave card parties, bake sales, socials and bazaars for the cause. By 1918 they had accumulated quite a fund. After meeting with Fr. Paquet to see what could be done and a cost determined, they resolved to wait until Spring of 1919. By then the ladies had \$1,300.

J.B. Deutch, president of the Lake Independence Lumber Co., donated the present site plus the rough lumber. A building committee was appointed by Father Korb who convinced Bishop Eis to let the church be built. Phil Aird, Dan O'Neill, Ed Sharkey and William Smith started the church. By the time the outside portions were completed they were broke. Goerge Leiphart of Munising was contracted to complete the outside and through special collections the interior was finished but in debt to the lumber company \$2,000. Bishop Eis blessed the church and administered the Sacrament of Confirmation. To be continued...




