When you have done all you have been commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do.'"



### St. Mary Mission History, cont'd from Sept. 28th:

During the time all the improvements were happening, the economic picture of Big Bay was changing. The Lake Independence Lumber Co. sold out to the Brunswick-Balke Co., then to Kerry-Hansen in 1935. The year 1942 brought in the Ford Motor Co., who took over the mill with the idea of erecting a model for the lumber industry.

Meanwhile, the congregation was dissatisfied with the interior of the church. They felt it lacked ecclesiastical design with the square windows and needed to be renovated to portray a more church-like dignity. In the fall of 1944, Franz Menze completed the costly job of lowering the ceiling of the nave, installing new windows and other repairs to the roof and basement. Once again the Parish Family assumed the burden of payment for a more suitable place of worship. A vestment case was built in the sacristy in 1948, new vestments acquired, the church exterior cleaned and the basement painted. To be continued...
