St. Mary Mission History, cont'd from Oct. 5th:

St. Mary's became a parish on October 21, 1948 with the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the church for the first time on December 25, 1948. Prior to this time the church was a Mission of the newly established St. Michaels. Now the administration came from the Chancery office when Fr. David Spelgatti was the first pastor assigned in October, 1948.

Once again the heating was changed to a bottle gas furnace to alleviate the need for a steady janitor, building fires, and coal hauling from Marquette.

The economic status of Big Bay in 1949 was grim. Rumors indicated that the lumbering business was over. So it was on June 15 that the last log was sawed and the Ford Mill ceased operations. Some 65 Catholic families in 1949 dwindled to half that in 1950. A small mill of the Northwestern Veneer Co. of Gladstone and the Crom and Crocker Mill provided employment for those remaining. The outlook wasn't improving but the parish donned the kneelers with pads and purchased a house to be used for a future parish residence or catechetical center. To be continued....






