St. Mary Mission History, cont'd from Oct. 12th:

When 1952 rolled around the economic situation changed a little with the establishment of the Big Bay Firing Point by the 5th Army at Lighthouse Point. Father Spelgatti was appointed auxiliary chaplain to serve the Catholic personnel. That same year, Fr. Spelgatti was named a Papal Chamberlain and the parish feted him October 4. Earlier in 1952, Ed Chaperone and his sons Lowell and Jack put Flintkote siding on the church and a gas range and refrigerator were purchased for the kitchen.

The shifting of population in the area was reflected in the parish census of 38 families, 12 bachelors, a total of 152 (77 adults, 72 children). The centennial issue of the Sunday Visitor in 1953 states: "The material progress of the parish is almost beyond understanding. How so few people could accomplish so much is known only to the God whom they serve and love."

A fine tribute to the many hard-working parishioners who cared about the spiritual welfare of its people. To be continued....




