FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 4th Sunday in Ordinary Time! This Sunday's Gospel presents the Beatitudes from Matthew 5:1-12, a core teaching of Jesus that invites us to a radical way of living. The Catechism of the Catholic

Church speaks of the Beatitudes as the heart of Jesus' preaching. In paragraphs 1716-1720, the Catechism teaches that the Beatitudes respond to the natural desire for happiness placed in every human heart and describe the vocation of the faithful to holiness and eternal life. They show us the way to true blessedness by pointing to values that often go against the logic of the world, such as poverty of spirit, meekness, mercy, and peacemaking.

The paradox of the Beatitudes lies in their promise of happiness through conditions that seem undesirable: poverty of spirit, mourning, and persecution. We can understand this paradox by embracing the fact that happiness is not ultimately found in material success or comfort, but in trusting God, loving others, and living according to Christ's example. The Beatitudes call us to see beyond what is current and popular and recognize the deeper joy that comes from living in communion with God.

On February 7th, we will be hosting a pre-Lenten party at 5:30pm: "Beat the Chill Chili Cookoff and Chiller Fundraiser." That's a lot of "chill." A sign-up sheet is in the gathering space. In addition to chili, bread, and salted butter, a **Cajun Seafood Boil** will be on the menu. Dats right, come and get it. Our defunct AC chiller is scheduled to be replaced this spring, and we aim to raise \$45,000 to cover expenses not met by insurance. Whether you're a chili connoisseur or simply love to sample, everyone is welcome. Bring your family and friends for an evening of delicious competition, warm fellowship, and great fun. Every dollar raised will help to ensure our Cathedral stays at a heaven-like temperature and not the contrary!

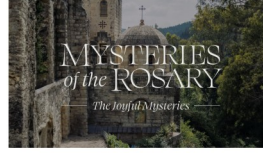

Martyrs and Monastics

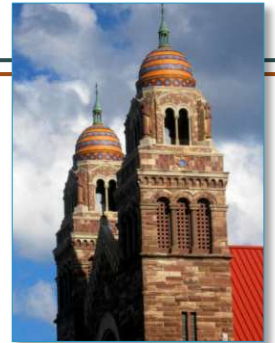

Monica Ashour is an author, international speaker, and founder of the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team. She holds two Masters' Degrees from the University of Dallas—one in Theological Studies and one in Humanities.

Listed in 2021 as one of the top Catholic women speakers and in 2010 by the *National Catholic Register* as one of the top six speakers on St. John Paul's Theology of the Body, Monica is the author of 28 books, including her Theology of the Body Marriage Preparation, lauded by Cardinal Dolan of New York and Archbishop Aquila in Denver.

Monica has presented at the Theology of the Body International Symposium and the International Summit on Lay Leadership in Rome, the National Catholic Leadership Conference in Orlando, and conferences in Australia and the Philippines.

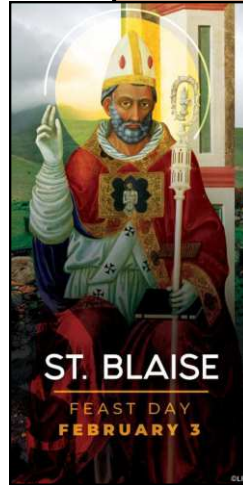
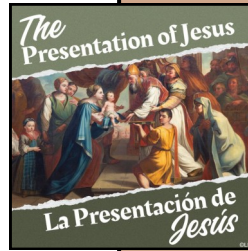

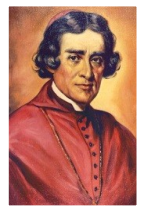
