FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Lord, every nation on earth will adore you" (Psalm 72).

Greetings and Salutations! Happy Feast of the Epiphany! This Feast reminds us of God's love revealed to all peoples. The visit of the Magi—wise men from the East who followed the star to Bethlehem—symbolizes the call of every nation and all peoples to worship the newborn King. Psalm 72 echoes the universal scope of Christ's mission: the salvation offered not just to Israel, but to all mankind. Let us open our hearts to God's presence and strive to share the light of Christ in our homes, school, workplaces, and communities. Isn't it interesting that Herod was afraid of Jesus and responded with violence; conversely, the Magi were captivated by Jesus and responded with worship. When you walk the path of God, expect opposition. But take courage! Like the Magi, you will find strength in paying your homage to the Lord, giving him the gift of yourself.
