

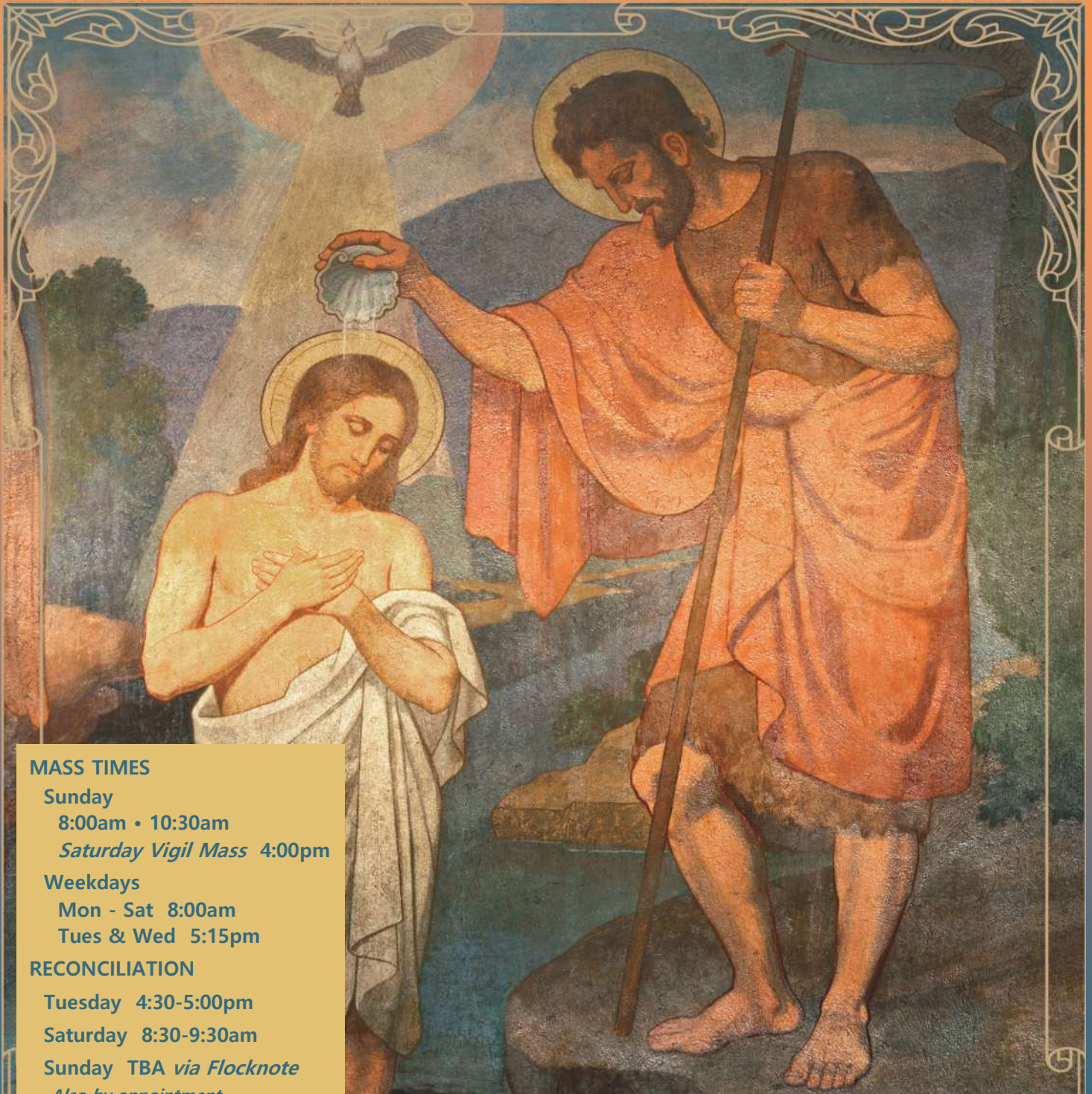

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. We recall that Jesus, though sinless, humbled Himself to be baptized by John in the Jordan. This action was not for him, but for others. St. Maximus of Turin reflects: "Someone might ask, 'Why would a holy man desire

Baptism?' Listen to the answer: Christ is baptized, not to be made holy by the water, but to make the water holy, and by his cleansing to purify the waters which he touched."

The Acts of the Apostles reminds us how, from the earliest days of the Church, Baptism was not only a sign of conversion but also a necessary step in salvation. After Peter's Pentecost sermon, the people asked, "What must we do?" Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins" (Acts 2:38). Baptism as the gateway to new life in Christ.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church affirms this sacred truth: "Baptism is necessary for salvation for those to whom the Gospel has been proclaimed and who have had the possibility of asking for this sacrament" (CCC 1257). Through Baptism, we are freed from sin (original sin and all personal sins), become adopted sons and daughters of God and partakers in the divine nature, made members of Christ and co-heirs with Him, made a Temple of the Holy Spirit, and made a member of the Body of Christ—the People of God—the Church. Baptism is the foundational sacrament upon which the Christian life is built.

On January 22nd, to thank God for the gift of life and to pray for a conversion of hearts and an end to abortion, we will host "All Day Adoration" in the Main Church, 8:30am to 6pm ending with Benediction. A sign-up sheet is on the bulletin board.

On February 7th, we will be hosting a pre-Lenten party at 5:30pm: "Beat the Chill Chili Cookoff and Chiller Fundraiser." That's a lot of "chill." A sign-up sheet for chili entries is in the gathering space. Our defunct AC chiller is scheduled to be replaced this spring, and we aim to raise \$45,000 to cover expenses not met by insurance. Whether you're a chili connoisseur or simply love to sample, everyone is welcome. Bring your family and friends for an evening of delicious competition, warm fellowship, and great fun. Every dollar raised will help to ensure our Cathedral stays at a heaven-like temperature and not the contrary!
