## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time! The Gospel reading comes from John 1:29-34. In this powerful passage, we hear St. John the Baptist declare, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!" His declaration makes plain to us that Jesus is not only the long-awaited Messiah but also the one who offers redemption and hope to every person. His willingness to take upon Himself our burdens and sins reveals the depth of God's love and mercy for all creation. Let us pray for one another and seek to be witnesses of Christ's love in our homes, schools, workplaces, and community.

On January 22nd, to thank God for the gift of life and to pray for a conversion of hearts and an end to abortion, we will host "All Day Adoration" in the Main Church, 8:30am to 6pm ending with Benediction. A sign-up sheet is on the bulletin board.

On February 7th, we will be hosting a pre-Lenten party at 5:30pm: "Beat the Chill Chili Cookoff and Chiller Fundraiser." That's a lot of "chill." A sign-up sheet for chili entries is in the gathering space. Our defunct AC chiller is scheduled to be replaced this spring, and we aim to raise \$45,000 to cover expenses not met by insurance. Whether you're a chili connoisseur or simply love to sample, everyone is welcome. Bring your family and friends for an evening of delicious competition, warm fellowship, and great fun. Every dollar raised will help to ensure our Cathedral stays at a heaven-like temperature and not the contrary!

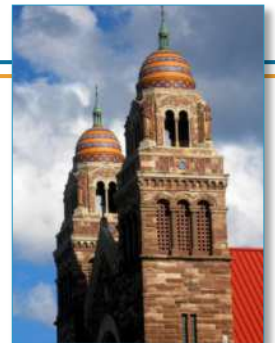

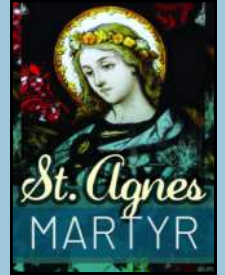

**Monica Ashour** is an author, international speaker, and founder of the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team. She holds two Masters' Degrees from the University of Dallas—one in Theological Studies and one in Humanities.
