FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time! This Sunday's Gospel presents us with the following summons from our Lord: "Follow me and I will make you fishers of men."

With these few words, our Lord called the first disciples, the brothers Peter and Andrew, inviting them to leave everything and follow Him on an adventure. Their willingness to respond changed their lives—and ours—forever. Today, Jesus continues to call. He calls each of us to follow him, and he calls some to a special vocation of service as priests. Our Church needs men of faith, courage, and generosity—men who are willing to cast their nets into the deep and bring others to Christ. This vocation is challenging but filled with joy and purpose, and our support is essential.

I encourage you to pray for our young men and boys, that they may hear God's call and have the strength to say "yes" to Him. Let us also support them in practical ways—by encouraging vocations, speaking positively about the priesthood, and fostering an environment where saying "yes" to God is celebrated and supported. If you know a young man who might be discerning, reach out to him with your encouragement and prayers.

On February 7th, we will be hosting a pre-Lenten party at 5:30pm: "Beat the Chill Chili Cookoff and Chiller Fundraiser." That's a lot of "chill." 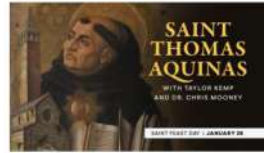

Monica Ashour is an author, international speaker, and founder of the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team. She holds two Masters' Degrees from the University of Dallas—one in Theological Studies and one in Humanities.

Listed in 2021 as one of the top Catholic women speakers and in 2010 by the *National Catholic Register* as one of the top six speakers on St. John Paul's Theology of the Body, Monica is the author of 28 books, including her Theology of the Body Marriage Preparation, lauded by Cardinal Dolan of New York and Archbishop Aquila in Denver.

Monica has presented at the Theology of the Body International Symposium and the International Summit on Lay Leadership in Rome, the National Catholic Leadership Conference in Orlando, and conferences in Australia and the Philippines.

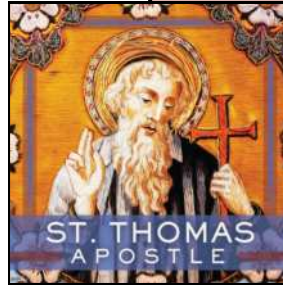
