



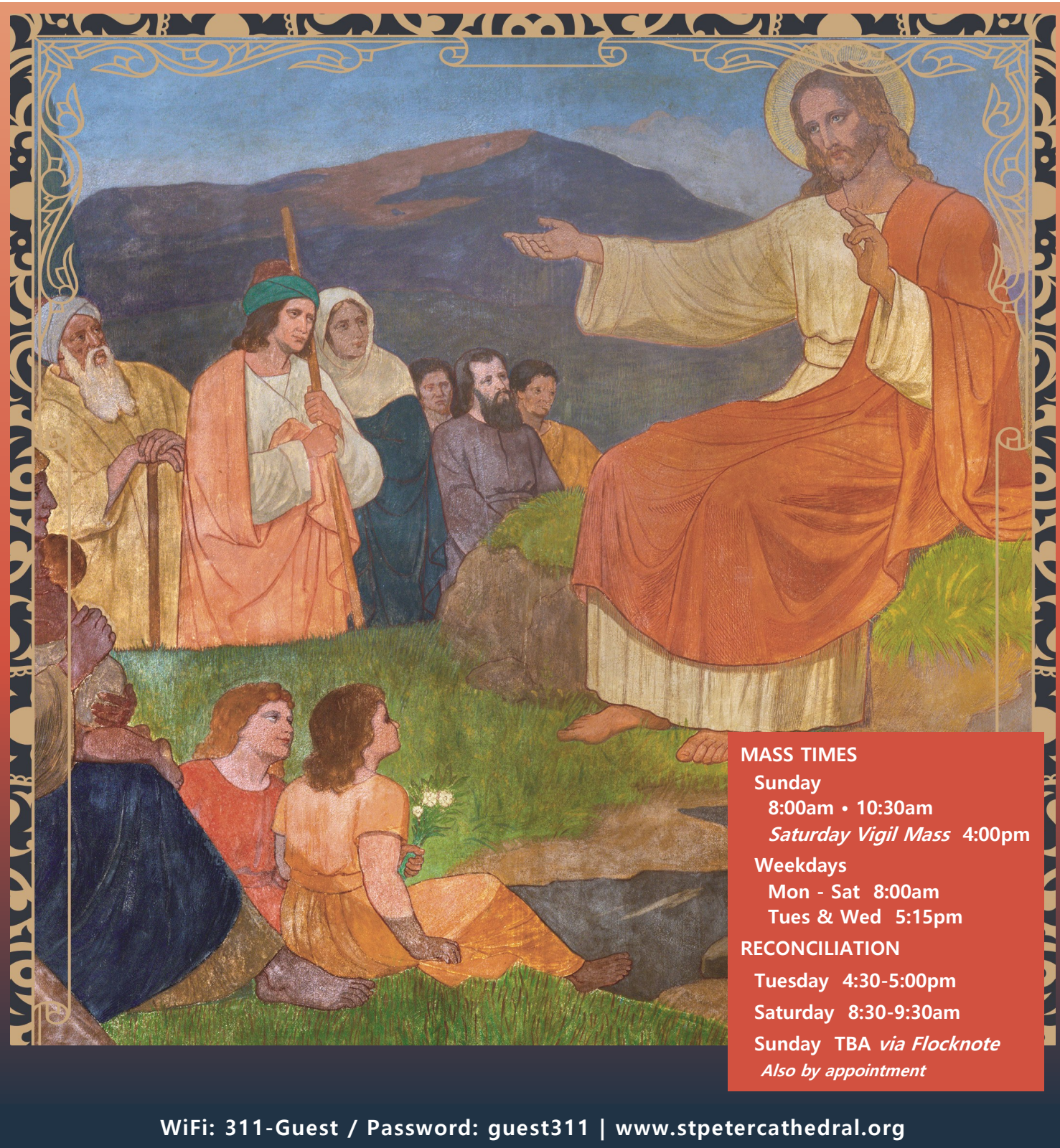

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time. We continue with the Sermon on the Mount this Sunday with the impactful statement of Jesus: "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden."

Each of us is called to reflect the light of Christ in our daily lives, offering hope, encouragement, and love to those around us. Whether it is through acts of kindness, a listening ear, or a simple prayer for someone in need, our gestures can illuminate the darkness and inspire others to seek God's presence. In a world often overshadowed by fear, your light—no matter how small—matters.

The season of Lent begins on February 18th with Ash Wednesday. Masses at SPC are at 8:00am and 5:30pm. At St. Mary Mission Mass is at 5:30pm. At St. Christopher Mass is at 12:10pm.

### Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of universal fast and abstinence. Fasting is obligatory for all who have completed their 18th year until the beginning of their 60th year. Fasting allows a person to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may be taken, not to equal one full meal. Abstinence (from meat) is obligatory for all who have completed their 14th year of age (c. 1252). If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday night) as the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus and to prepare to share more fully and celebrate more readily his Resurrection (see *Sacrosanctum Concilium*, 109). Fridays in Lent are obligatory days of abstinence (from meat) for all who have completed their 14th year. As always, anyone for whom fasting or abstinence would pose a health risk is excused.

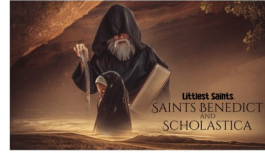

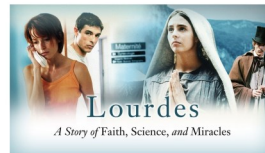
### Sts. Benedict and Scholastica

### Lourdes: Story of Faith, Science,

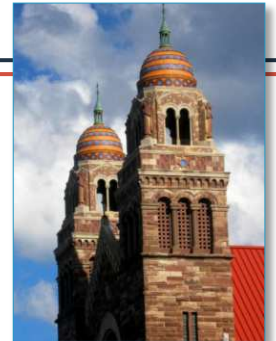
The film follows a journalist, his ancestor who met Bernadette at Lourdes, and the story of a woman healed by Lourdes' waters, tracing three lives.

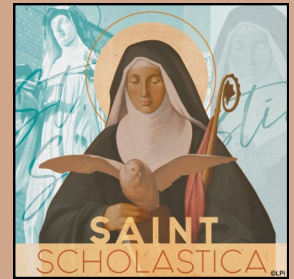

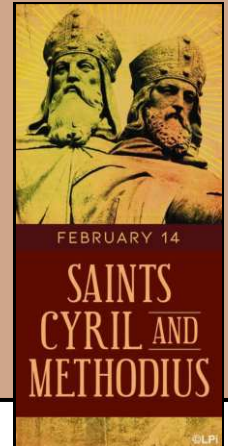
