

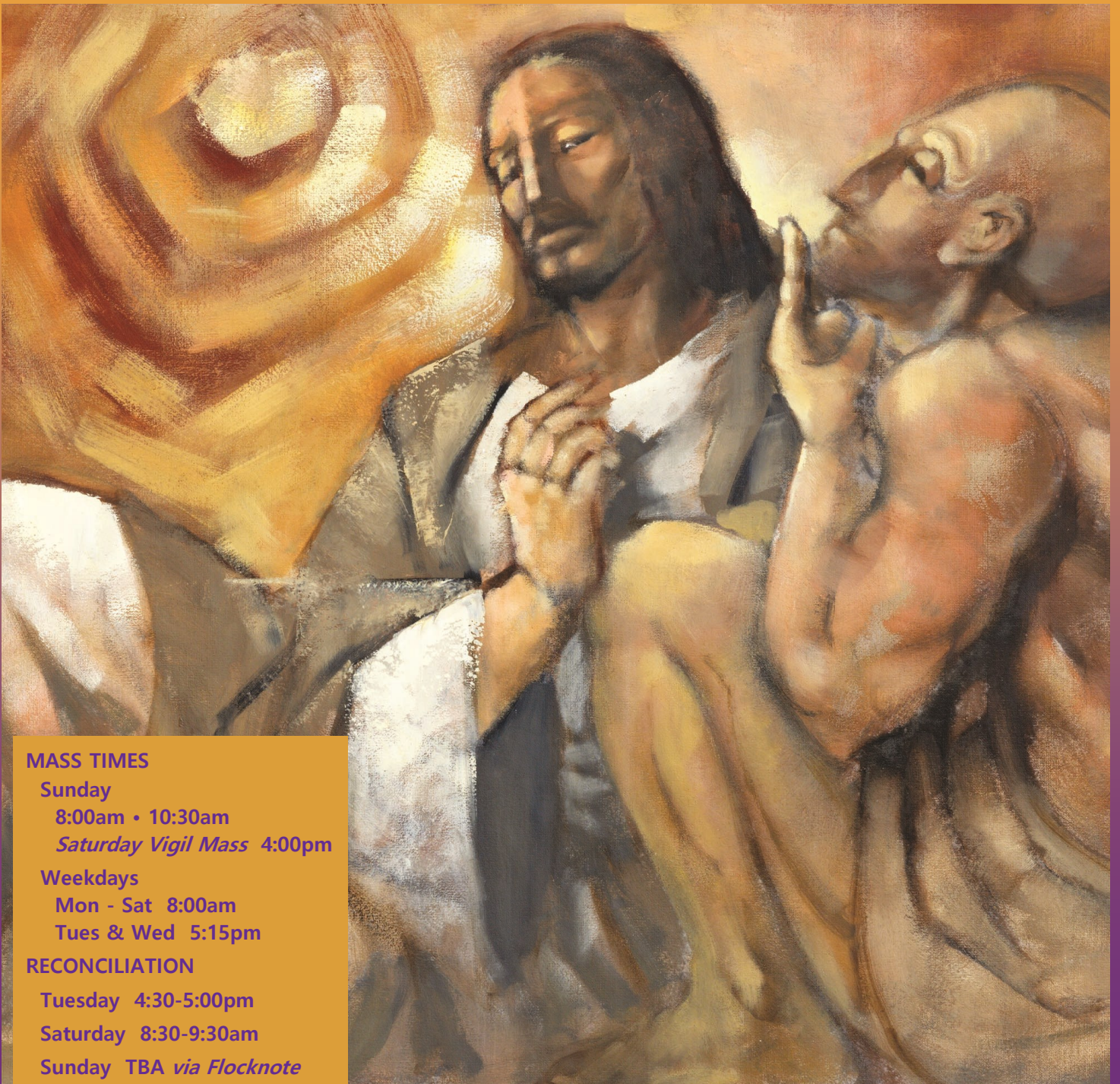

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations!  
Happy 1st Sunday of Lent! Lent is a period of forty days, a time of preparation for Easter, echoing the forty days Jesus spent in the desert praying and fasting before his public ministry. It is a special time for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving,

which are the three pillars of our Lenten observance. This season calls us to a renewal of our baptismal commitment and an inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ more faithfully.

The Gospel for this Sunday recounts the temptation of Jesus in the wilderness. After fasting for forty days, Jesus was tempted by the devil. He was tempted with comfort, with power, and with a spectacular display of His divinity. In each instance, Jesus resisted, armed with the Word of God, choosing instead the path of obedience to the Father. This Gospel account sets the tone for our Lenten journey, reminding us that we too are called to confront and overcome the temptations in our own lives with the help of God's grace. During this season, I encourage you to embrace the traditional practices of Lent:

**Prayer:** Deepen your relationship with God through personal and communal prayer. Consider attending daily Mass, praying the Stations of the Cross, or spending quiet time in reflection on the Sacred Scriptures.

**Fasting:** Practice self-control through fasting and abstinence. This is not just about giving up certain foods, but about creating a space for God in our lives and growing in self-discipline.

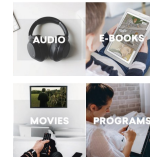
**Almsgiving:** Share your time, talents, and treasure with those in need. This is a witness to fraternal charity and a work of justice that is pleasing to God.

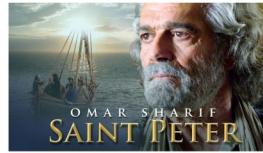

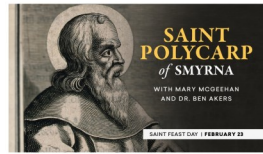
### Foretold

### St. Polycarp | Catholic Saints

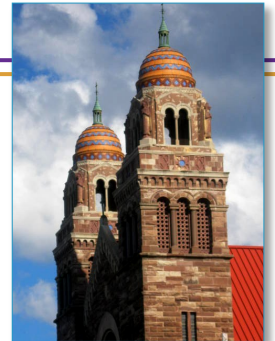

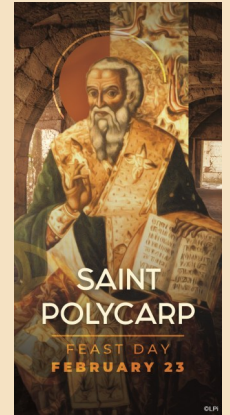

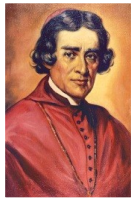

*Notes from*  
**VENERABLE FREDERIC BARAGA**  
*First Bishop of Marquette*

From Barrie to Toronto, where I did not stay long because the bishop [Charbonnel] was not there. In the evening I continued my journey and came to the Suspension Bridge where I spent the night. This Suspension Bridge over the St. Lawrence [Niagara] River, at the foot of Niagara Falls is a stupendous work so solid that the heaviest train runs over it in safety.
