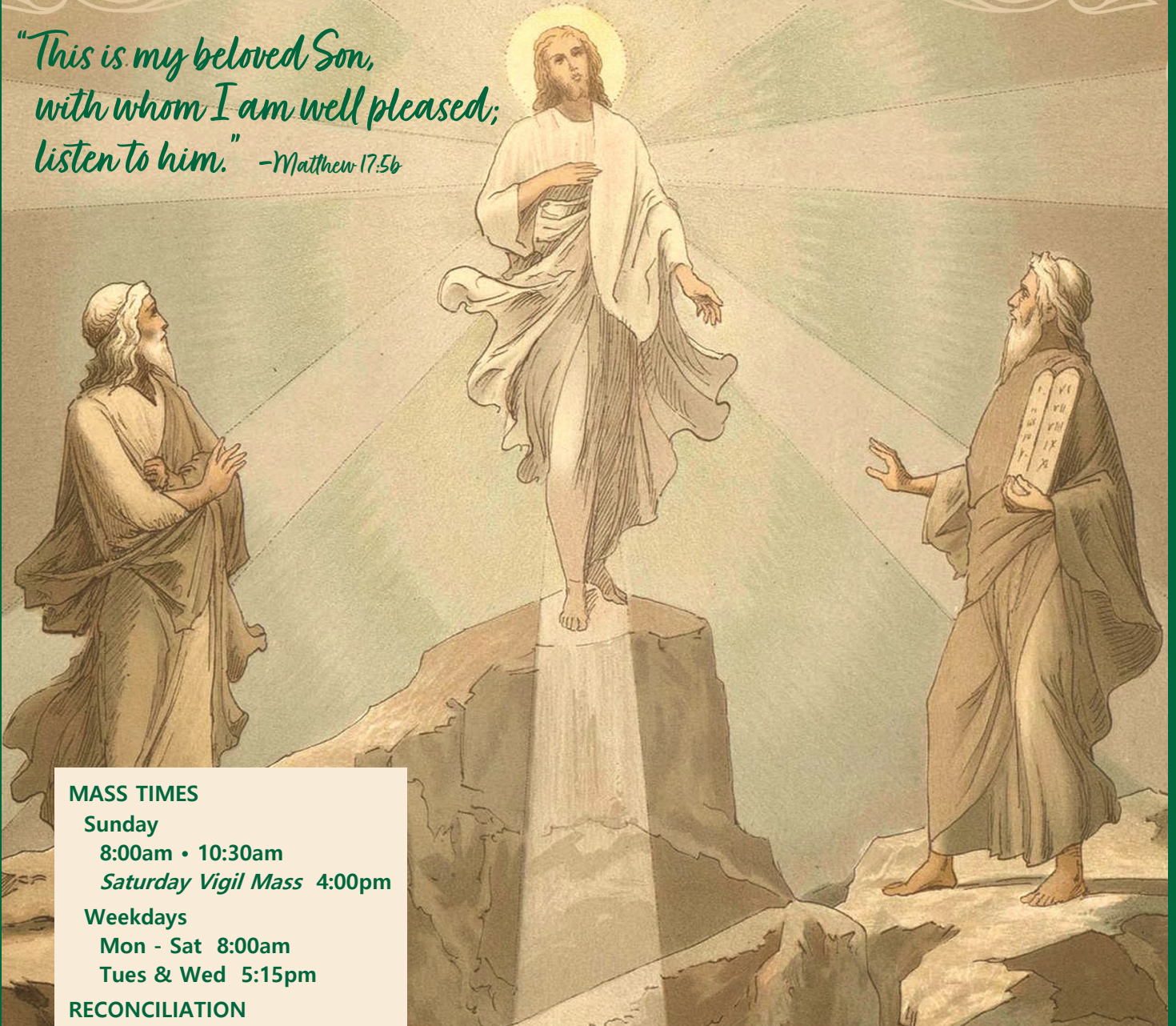

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations!  
Happy 2nd Sunday of Lent! The Gospel is the Transfiguration of Jesus as described in Matthew. In this pivotal moment, Jesus reveals His divine glory to Peter, James, and John atop the mountain, affirming His identity as the beloved Son of God. This scene encourages us to lift our hearts and eyes to the hope that comes from following Christ.

The Transfiguration is a revelation of Jesus' divinity, and a powerful encouragement for us as we face the challenges and crosses in our own lives. Right before this event, Jesus tells His disciples about the necessity of the cross: "If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me" (Matthew 16:24). He makes plain that suffering and sacrifice are part of our Christian journey, but they are never the end of the story. The transformation on the mountain assures us that the cross leads to triumph, not defeat. The glory revealed in Jesus foreshadows the resurrection that awaits all who remain faithful to Him.

As we continue through Lent, let us be encouraged and strengthened by the Transfiguration of Jesus. May we embrace our crosses, trusting that God's grace will sustain us and that we too are invited share in the triumph of Christ.

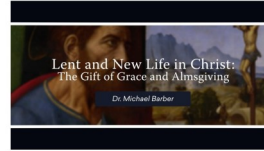

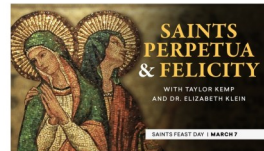

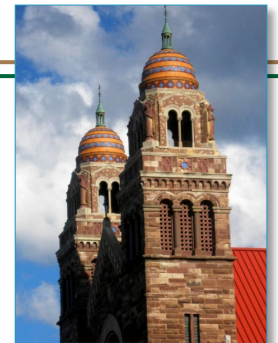
### Sts. Perpetua

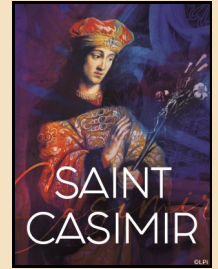

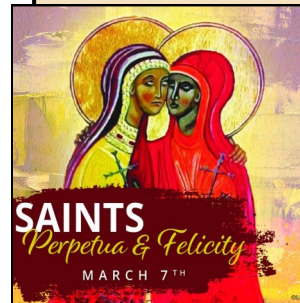
