FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations!

Happy 3rd Sunday of Lent! In today's Gospel, Jesus—tired from His journey—sits at Jacob's well and begins with a simple request: "Give me a drink" (Jn 4:7). He meets the Samaritan woman right

where she is, speaking the truth with mercy. Lent is our invitation to let Him do the same with us.

Jesus promises "living water" that truly satisfies (Jn 4:14): not another quick fix, but the Holy Spirit filling a thirsty heart. He calls us to worship "in Spirit and truth" (Jn 4:23). With God's grace always going before us, the timeless Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, almsgiving, and confession bring abundant renewal to our lives and parish.

Prayer brings us back to the only source of life. Fasting teaches us that we do not have to be ruled by our appetites. Almsgiving loosens our grip on possessions and self-protection. Confession releases us from the chains of the powers of darkness.

Jesus promises "living water": "Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst" (Jn 4:14). How many "wells" do we return to, expecting them to make us happy—approval, money, comfort, busyness, resentment, endless scrolling, or the illusion that we can manage life without prayer?

This week, I invite you to do three things: (1) take five quiet minutes each day and tell the Lord honestly where you feel thirsty; (2) choose one "false well" to step back from (a habit, a purchase, a complaint, a screen); and (3) reach out to one person who may feel far from God or far from the Church, and, like the woman at the well, offer an invitation—your story of how Christ has met you.

A prayer by St. Padre Pio: "My past, O Lord, to your mercy. My present, to your love. My future, to your providence."

Lenten Events: The Stations of the Cross are prayed on Fridays during Lent at 6:30pm. Before the stations on Friday, March 27th, head to the parish hall at 5:30pm for soup, bread, and other homemade meatless dishes. There will be plenty of food for all and bring a dish to share if you are able.

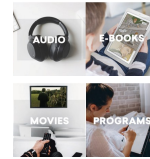

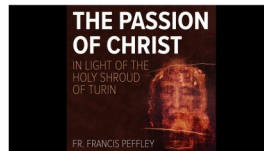
How to Lent

Notes from
VENERABLE FREDERIC BARAGA
First Bishop of Marquette

The missionaries told me that most of the people in their missions, consisting of Indians, half-Indians, and Canadians, are fishermen, and that as soon as the ice on Lakes Huron and Michigan thaws they go fishing, 50-80 miles away, and there they spend the entire spring and summer. The missionaries endeavor to visit them on their fishing shores from time to time, to offer mass, preach and distribute the Holy Sacrament among them.

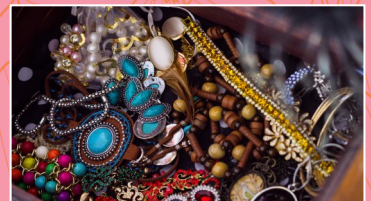
