

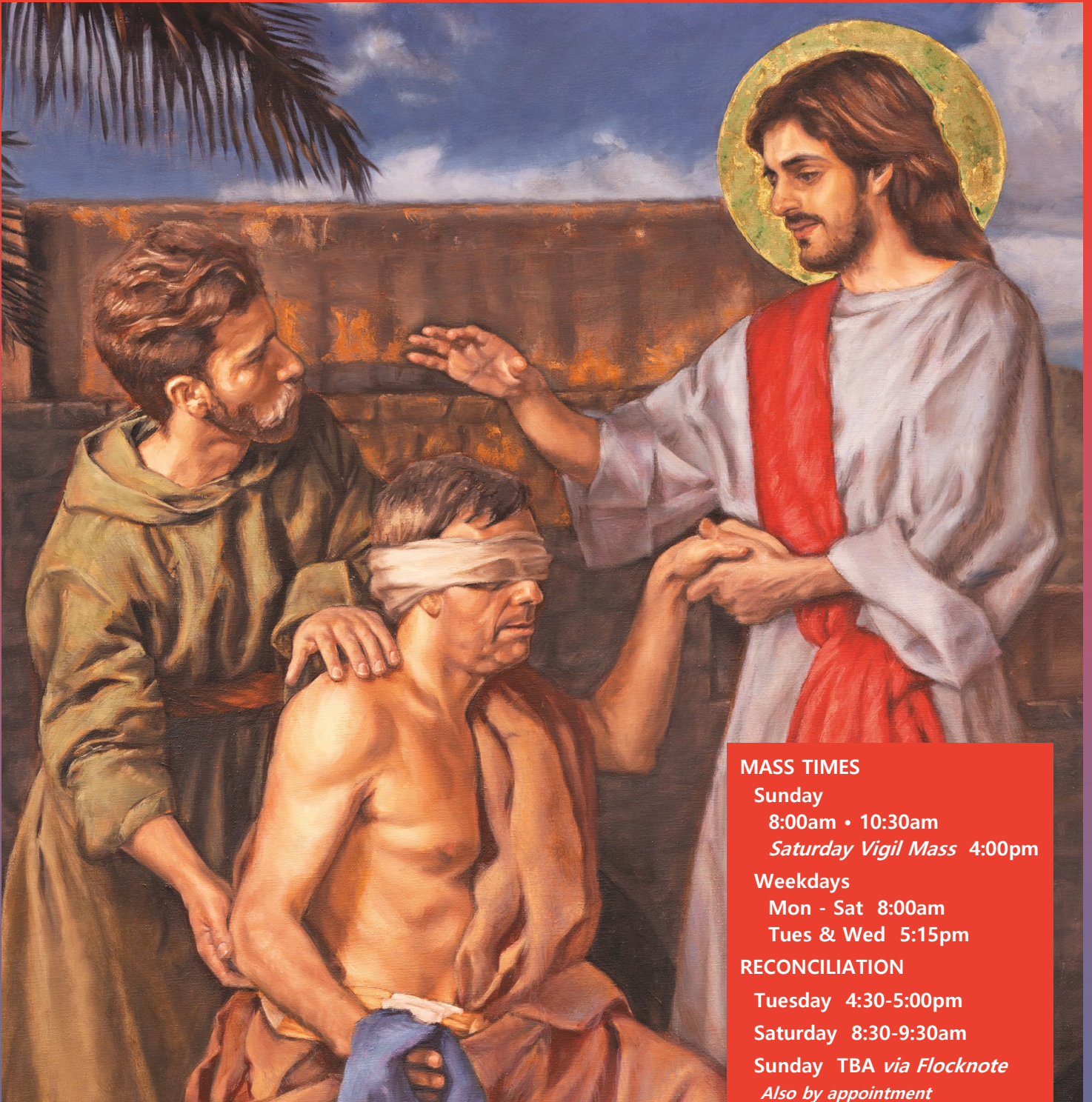

Happy *Laetare Sunday*, the 4th Sunday of Lent! Midway through Lent the Church says *Laetare*—"Rejoice." In John 9:1-41, Jesus, the Light of the world, heals a man born blind and reveals

what true sight is, namely faith. We were brought from darkness to light through faith and Baptism. Rejoice!

Pancake Breakfast! Join us this Sunday, March 15th for breakfast in the parish hall. The proceeds will benefit the Nickolas Boyle family.

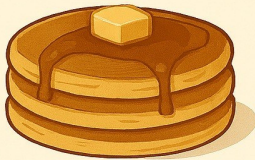

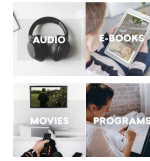

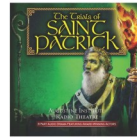

Patrick: Brave Shepherd of the Emerald Isle

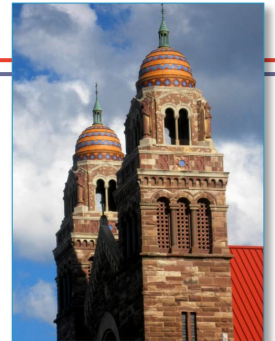

- welcome and serve our community, especially the less fortunate and one another.



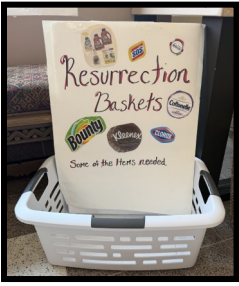

Teaching the Theology of the Body to Tots, Tweens, and Teens

Monica Ashour is an author, international speaker, and founder of the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team. She holds two Masters' Degrees from the University of Dallas—one in Theological Studies and one in Humanities.

Listed in 2021 as one of the top Catholic women speakers and in 2010 by the *National Catholic Register* as one of the top six speakers on St. John Paul's Theology of the Body, Monica is the author of 28 books, including her Theology of the Body Marriage Preparation, lauded by Cardinal Dolan of New York and Archbishop Aquila in Denver.

Monica has presented at the Theology of the Body International Symposium and the International Summit on Lay Leadership in Rome, the National Catholic Leadership Conference in Orlando, and conferences in Australia and the Philippines.

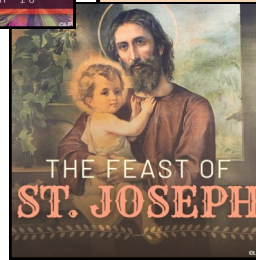

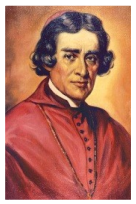

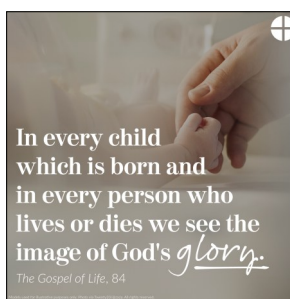
