

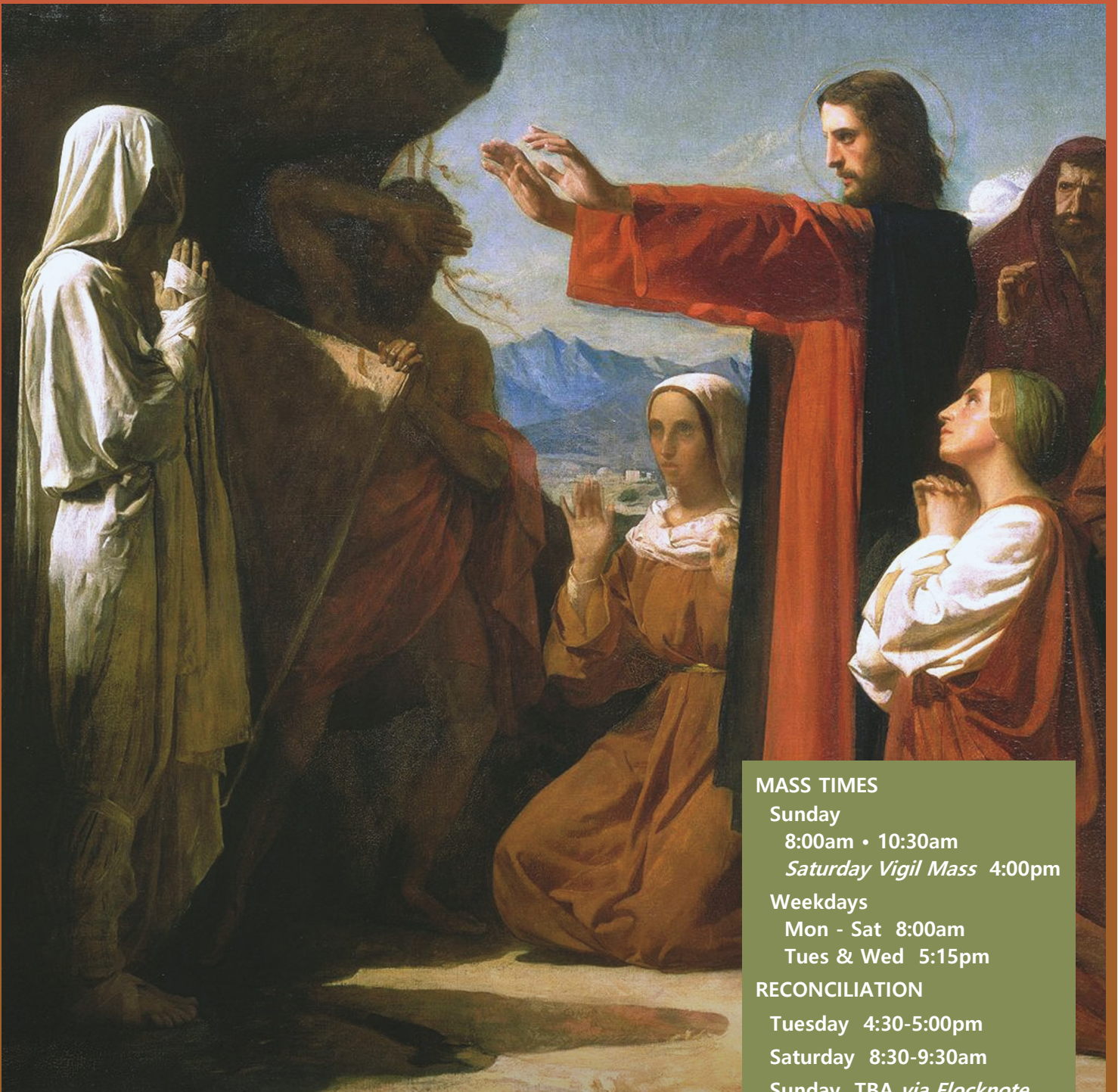

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 5th Sunday of Lent! In this Sunday's Gospel from the **Gospel of St. John (11:1-45)**, Jesus raises Lazarus from the dead. Arriving after Lazarus has been in the tomb for four days, Jesus encounters the grief of Martha and Mary. In the midst of their sorrow, He proclaims: "I AM the resurrection and the life." This powerful moment reveals both Jesus' deep concern—He weeps with those who mourn—and His divine authority over death. When He calls Lazarus out of the tomb, He shows that death does not have the final word. As we approach Holy Week, this Gospel invites us to trust that Christ can bring life even to the darkest moments of our lives.

## Resurrection Baskets

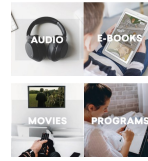

### The Annunciation: Hail Mary

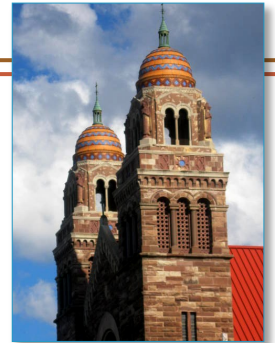

### Teaching the Theology of the Body to Tots, Tweens, and Teens

Monica Ashour is an author, international speaker, and founder of the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team. She holds two Masters' Degrees from the University of Dallas—one in Theological Studies and one in Humanities.

Listed in 2021 as one of the top Catholic women speakers and in 2010 by the *National Catholic Register* as one of the top six speakers on St. John Paul's Theology of the Body, Monica is the author of 28 books, including her Theology of the Body Marriage Preparation, lauded by Cardinal Dolan of New York and Archbishop Aquila in Denver.

Monica has presented at the Theology of the Body International Symposium and the International Summit on Lay Leadership in Rome, the National Catholic Leadership Conference in Orlando, and conferences in Australia and the Philippines.

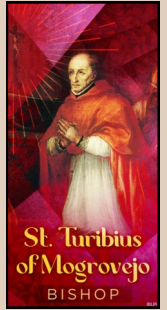
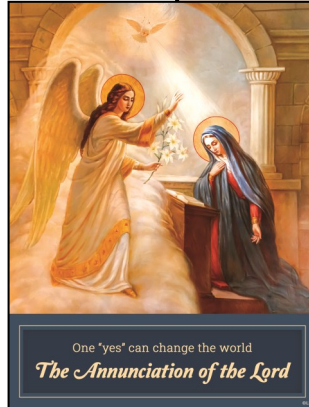

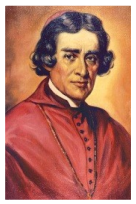

## Give us this day our daily bread.....

**Lessons from the Catechism of the Council of Trent:**  
*Why the Holy Eucharist Is Called Our "Daily" Bread*

The Eucharist is called daily (bread) for two reasons. The first is that it is daily offered to God in the sacred mysteries of the Christian Church and is given to those who seek it piously and holily. The second is that it should be received daily, or, at least, that we should so live as to be worthy, as far as possible, to receive it daily. Let those who hold the contrary, and who say that we should not partake of this salutary banquet of the soul but at distant intervals, hear what St. Ambrose says: *If it is daily bread, why do you receive it yearly?*
