Greetings and Salutations! Happy Palm Sunday! Today we enter the mystery of Holy Week by walking with the Lord from triumph to the Cross. We begin with joyful palms and cries of "Hosanna," yet we soon proclaim the

Passion of Jesus. How quickly hearts can change! In this sacred liturgy, we are invited not only to observe these events, but to take our place within them. 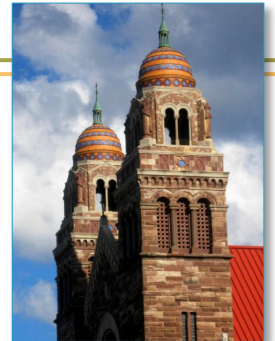
The Last Days: The Passion and Death of Jesus the Christ w/ Jonathan Roumie

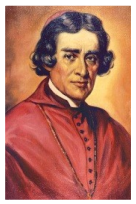

Evangelization Department SUMMER INTERN

The Diocese of Marquette Evangelization Department is seeking a summer intern for 12 weeks from May 11th – July 31st, 2026. The intern will have the opportunity to develop leadership skills, gain experience in ministry, and contribute to the department mission to equip Catholics with training and resources to grow in friendship with Jesus, invest in relationships with others, and invite those in their circles of influence to discover and follow Christ.

Responsibilities: • Contribute to ongoing projects and programs within the department, bringing new perspectives and ideas; • Facilitate relationship development with parishes, organizations, and stakeholders; • Help develop and assist with summer youth programming including Give, Serve, Love; High School Leadership Camp; and Catholic Summer Camp; • Expand Diocesan 2027 Eucharistic Congress plans; • Assist with Diocesan Confirmation record keeping; • Seek out opportunities to contribute to the success of the department.

Requirements: • Be a practicing Catholic in love with Jesus, with a passion for serving the Lord and developing leadership skills; • Have completed at least one year of college or equivalent experience; • Availability for the entirety of the internship, including approximately 20 weekly hours, with increased hours the weeks of June 15-18, July 13-16, and July 19-23 for overnight camps. Because of this, the intern will have off the entire week preceding July 4. Administrative aspects of this role account for less than 20% of the time. Most of the Intern’s duties will include collaboration, brainstorming and executing ideas, promotion of events both on social media and in person, and working to foster relationships and involvement.

Compensation: • This is a paid 12-week internship with a stipend of \$3,500 paid over the course of the internship; • A room in the Marquette area will be provided for the duration of the internship.
