FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Today, we rejoice in the central fact of our faith: **Jesus Christ is truly risen from the dead.** St. Paul, based on his personal encounters with the Risen Lord, writes, **"If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain" (1 Corinthians 15:14).** But Christ *has* been raised, and because He lives, our lives have a new trajectory.

In today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, St. Peter proclaims the saving truth of Easter: Jesus, anointed by God, went about doing good, healing, and revealing the mercy of the Father. Though He was put to death on the cross, **God raised Him on the third day.** Peter testifies that the apostles are witnesses to His Resurrection and that **everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins through His name.**

Easter is not merely the memory of a past event. It is the victory of Christ made present to us now. The risen Lord offers us mercy, hope, and new life. Let us then live as Easter people — confident that sin, sorrow, and even death do not have the final word. God bless you!

Lessons from the Catechism of the Council of Trent: *The Resurrection of the Body*

We have said that the body is to rise again, that every one may receive the proper things of the body, (@ Cor. 5:10). Man is, therefore, to rise again in the same body with which he served God, or was a slave to the devil; that in the same body he may experience rewards and a crown of victory, or endure the severest punishments and torments.

"Like us, Christ entered the world through the womb of a woman. He willingly experienced the fullness of human suffering. He breathed his last on the Cross at Calvary in order that He might save us. Therefore, 'God is the foundation of hope: not any god, but the God who has a human face and who has loved us to the end' (Spe salvi 31)."
