## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 3rd Sunday of Easter! The Church gives us an excerpt from the first homily of St. Peter the Apostle on Pentecost—a simple and powerful summary of the good news. The homily in entirety is found in Acts 2:14-36. St. Peter proclaims Jesus Christ: His life filled with miracles and signs, His suffering and crucifixion, and His resurrection and exaltation at the right hand of the Father. This is the heart of our faith. St. Peter's message reminds us that Christianity is not an idea, but an event, an encounter with a person: something God has done in history. The same Jesus who walked among His disciples, who died and rose, is still alive and present to us in His Church.

Like those who first heard St. Peter, we are invited to respond with faith and conversion. This Easter season, let us return to the basics of the Gospel: to know Jesus, to love Him, to follow Him in His Catholic Church family, and to bear witness that He is truly risen and reigning in glory.

**Save the Dates:** The annual procession and picnic for Corpus Christi follows the 10:30am Mass on June 7th. Our annual parish festival on our patronal feast—the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul—is Sunday, June 28th after the 10:30am Mass. Invite your friends!

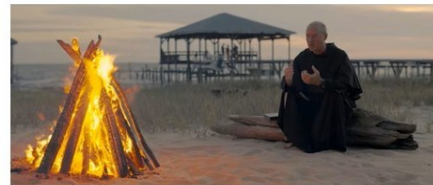
# BAKE SALE

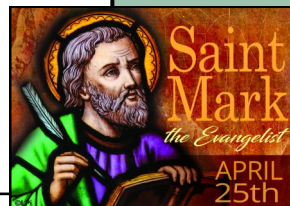

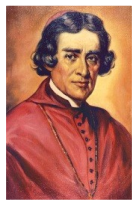

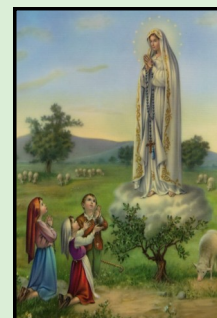
