



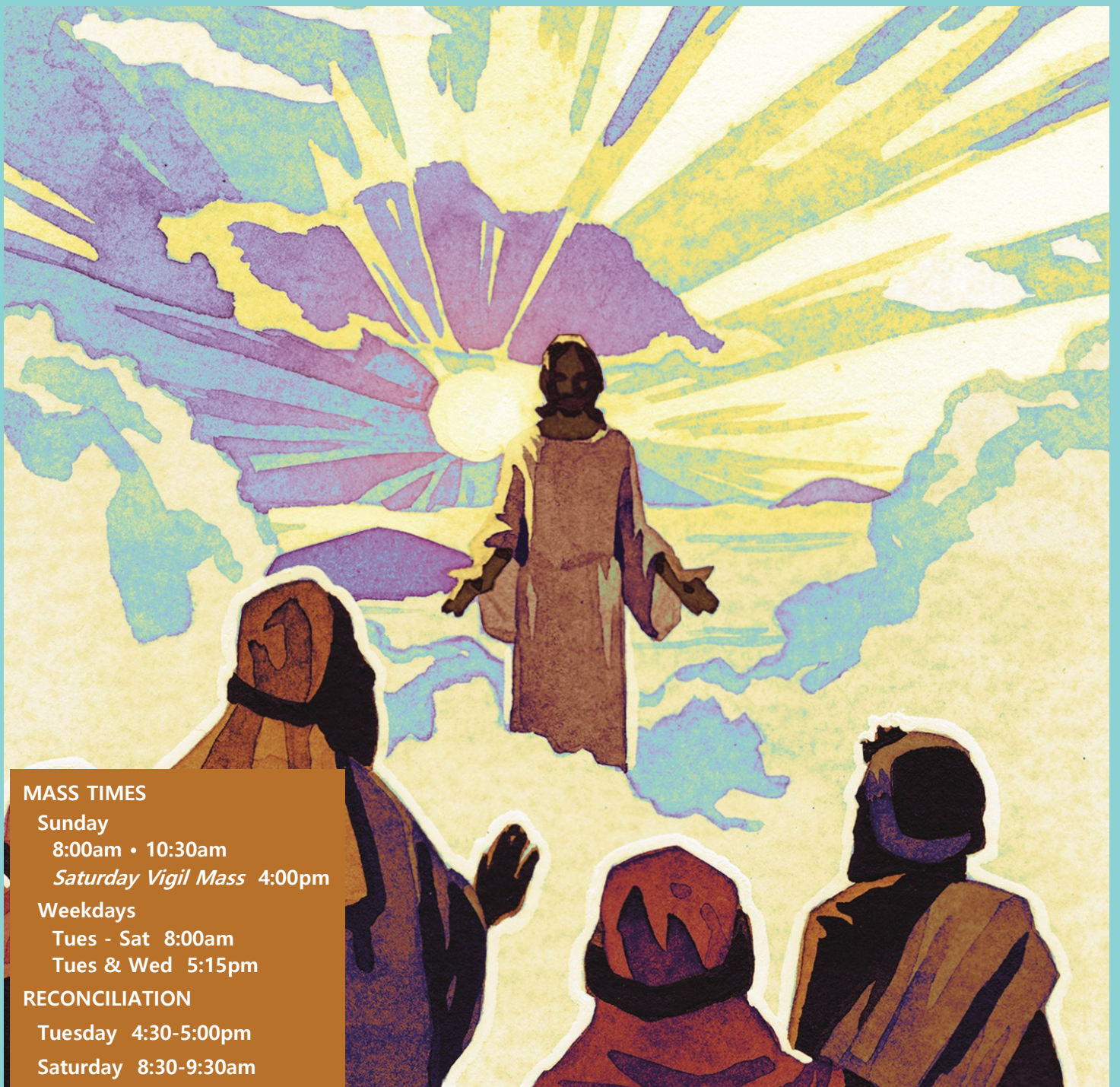

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord! In today's first reading, Jesus is taken up to his Father in heaven. Bishop Robert Barron reflects that "We tend to read the Ascension along essentially Enlightenment lines rather than biblical lines—and that causes a good deal of mischief.

Enlightenment thinkers introduced a two-tier understanding of heaven and earth. They held that God exists, but that he lives in a distant realm called heaven, where he looks at the human project moving along, pretty much on its own steam, on earth. On this Enlightenment reading, the Ascension means that Jesus goes up, up, and away, off to a distant and finally irrelevant place. But the biblical point is this: Jesus has gone to heaven so as to direct operations more fully here on earth. That's why we pray, "Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Jesus has not gone up, up, and away, but rather—if I can put it this way—more deeply into our world. He has gone to a dimension that transcends but impinges upon our universe."

Parish News! Effective July 1, 2026, Fr. Zachary Mazurek has been appointed parochial vicar (associate pastor) for St. Peter Cathedral and St. Mary Mission and the Director of Vocations for the Diocese of Marquette, MI. Essentially, his time will be split between both positions. He will travel often during the week and on the weekends, promoting vocations. Therefore, the Mass schedule will remain "as is" at SPC and SMM. His day off will be Monday, aligning with mine so we can maximize our time at the parishes. Please keep Fr. Zachary in your prayers.

Save the Dates: On Pentecost Sunday, May 24th, we will host the annual baccalaureate Mass at 10:30am for our High School Graduates. Graduates should wear their caps, gown and regalia. On June 5 at 3:30pm at SPC, three men will be ordained priests for Diocese of Marquette. Join us! The annual procession and picnic for Corpus Christi follows the 10:30am Mass on June 7th. Our annual parish festival on our patronal feast—the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul—is Sunday, June 28th after the 10:30am Mass. Invite your friends!
