FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy Pentecost Sunday! Pentecost gives us an insight into the mission of the Holy Spirit: to unite what sin and pride have divided. Reflecting on this mystery, Saint Augustine taught that the many tongues in which people spoke and understood at the Pentecost event were a

sign that the Gospel would be proclaimed to every nation. He contrasted Pentecost with the Tower of Babel: at Babel, human pride divided humanity into many languages; at Pentecost, the humble faith of believers brought all these diverse languages into the unity of the Church. St. Augustine wrote, "What discord had scattered, love was to gather together." The Holy Spirit continues this mission today, bringing God's love into the world and uniting hearts through charity, peace, and truth.

Parish News! Effective July 1, 2026, Fr. Zachary Mazurek has been appointed parochial vicar (associate pastor) for St. Peter Cathedral and St. Mary Mission and the Director of Vocations for the Diocese of Marquette, MI. 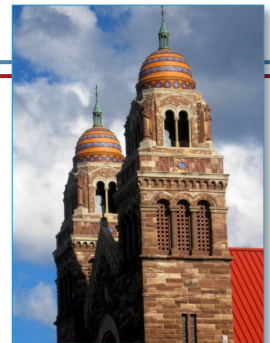
The Wild Goose

Lessons from the Catechism of the Council of Trent: The Lord's Prayer: "Thy Will Be Done"

When...we pray, *Thy will be done*, we first of all ask our heavenly Father to give us the strength to obey His Commandments, and to serve Him *in holiness and justice all our days* (John 1:12); to do all things according to His Will and pleasure; to discharge all the duties prescribed for us in Sacred Scripture; under His guidance and assistance to perform all that becomes those who are born, *not of the will of the flesh but of God* (Luke 1:75), thus following the example of Christ the Lord *who was made obedient unto death, even unto the death of the cross* (Phil. 2:8); finally to be ready to bear all things rather than depart from His holy will in even the slightest degree.
