



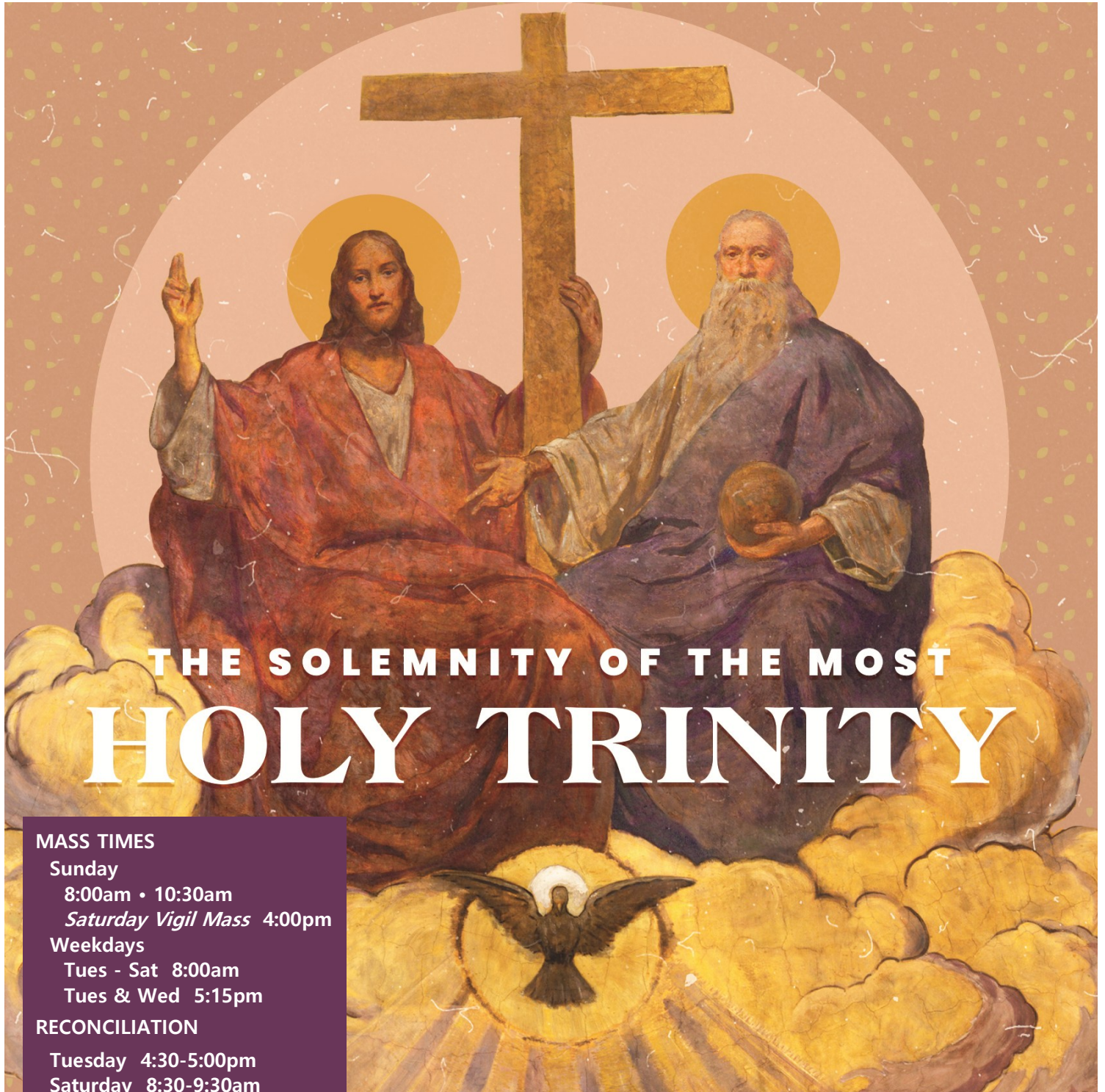

Greetings and Salutations! Happy Trinity Sunday! The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us that the mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith. Christians believe in one God who exists eternally as three divine Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three

Persons are distinct from one another, yet they are perfectly united in one divine nature. The Father is the source without origin, the Son is eternally begotten of the Father, and the Holy Spirit proceeds from the Father and the Son.

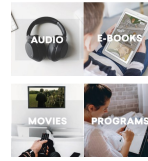

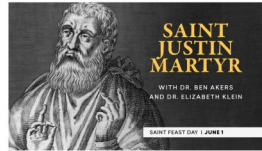

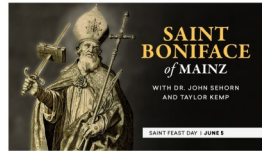
Lectio: God

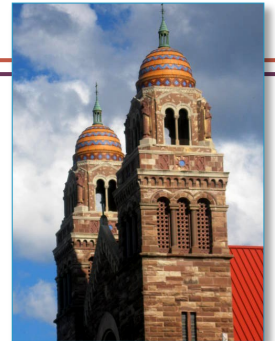
Saint Justin Martyr | Catholic Saints
