



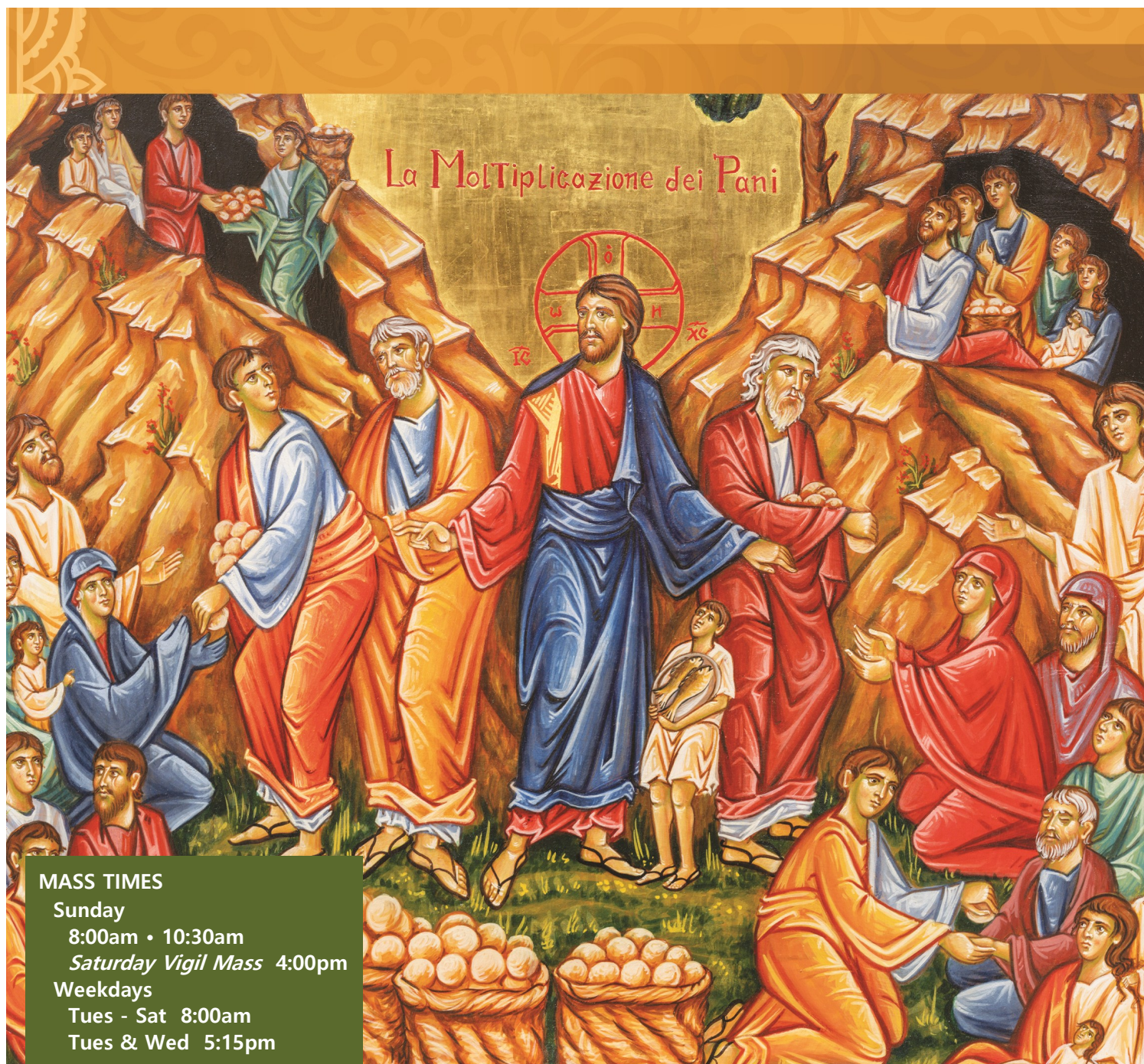

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy Solemnity of Corpus Christi! On the great gift of the Eucharist, St. John Paul II wrote: Eucharistic communion also confirms the Church in her unity as the body of Christ. Saint Paul refers to this unifying power of participation in the banquet of the Eucharist when he writes to the Corinthians:

“The bread which we break, is it not a communion in the body of Christ? Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread” (1 Cor 10:16-17). Saint John Chrysostom's commentary on these words is profound and perceptive: “For what is the bread? It is the body of Christ. And what do those who receive it become? The Body of Christ – not many bodies but one body. For as bread is completely one, though made of up many grains of wheat, and these, albeit unseen, remain nonetheless present, in such a way that their difference is not apparent since they have been made a perfect whole, so too are we mutually joined to one another and together united with Christ”. The argument is compelling: our union with Christ, which is a gift and grace for each of us, makes it possible for us, in him, to share in the unity of his body which is the Church. The Eucharist reinforces the incorporation into Christ which took place in Baptism though the gift of the Spirit (cf. 1 Cor 12:13, 27). (John Paul II, *Ecclesia de Eucharistia* no. 23)

Corpus Christi Procession and Picnic: Please join us for the annual Corpus Christi Procession which will follow directly after the 10:30am Mass. Following the same route around the block as last year, our procession will begin and end at St. Peter Cathedral. After 12:30pm Benediction, join us for a picnic lunch provided by Border Grill.

Our annual **Parish Festival** on our patronal feast—the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul—is Sunday, June 28th after the 10:30am Mass. Invite your friends! If you would like to bring a dish to pass, please sign up on the bulletin board. Two **Dominican priests** will offer a mission at St. Peter Cathedral **July 18-21**. They will offer Masses, hear Confessions, promote the Rosary, and facilitate the veneration of the relic of St. Jude the Apostle.

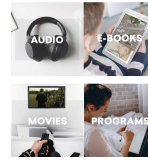

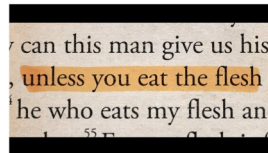

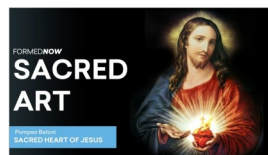
Bread of Life: The Eucharist in Galilee

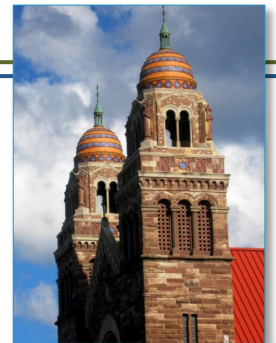
Presence

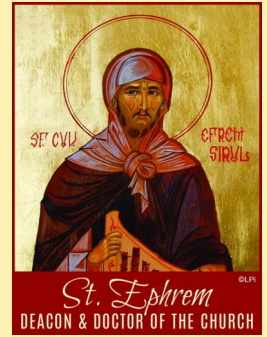

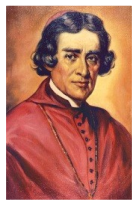

First Bishop of Marquette

This spring a solemnity has come up which in this poor, remote diocese has as yet never taken place, namely, laying the corner stone of a new church...Now, in an important location on Lake Superior, a big church is being built, which, although it will also be built only of wood, its foundation, however, has been laid deep in the ground and regularly built with stone.

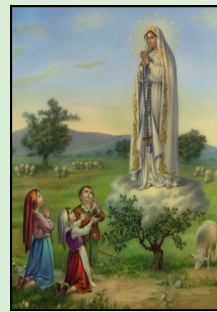

Lessons from the Catechism of the Council of Trent: The Lord's Prayer: "Give us this day our daily bread."

Christ Himself is our bread..... our food for the soul.....in the Sacrament of the Eucharist....

The Eucharist is called *OUR* bread, because it is the food of the faithful only, that is to say, of those who uniting charity to faith, wash away the defilement of their sins in the Sacrament of Penance, and mindful that they are the children of God, receive and adore this divine Sacrament with all possible holiness and veneration.

The Eucharist is called *daily* (bread) for two reasons. The first is that it is daily offered to God in the sacred mysteries of the Christian Church and is given to those who seek it piously and holily. The second is that it should be received daily, or, at least, that we should so live as to be worthy, as far as possible, to receive it daily. Let those who hold the contrary, and who say that we should not partake of this salutary banquet of the soul but at distant intervals, hear what St. Ambrose says: *If it is daily bread, why do you receive it yearly?*

Next week: "And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors."
