



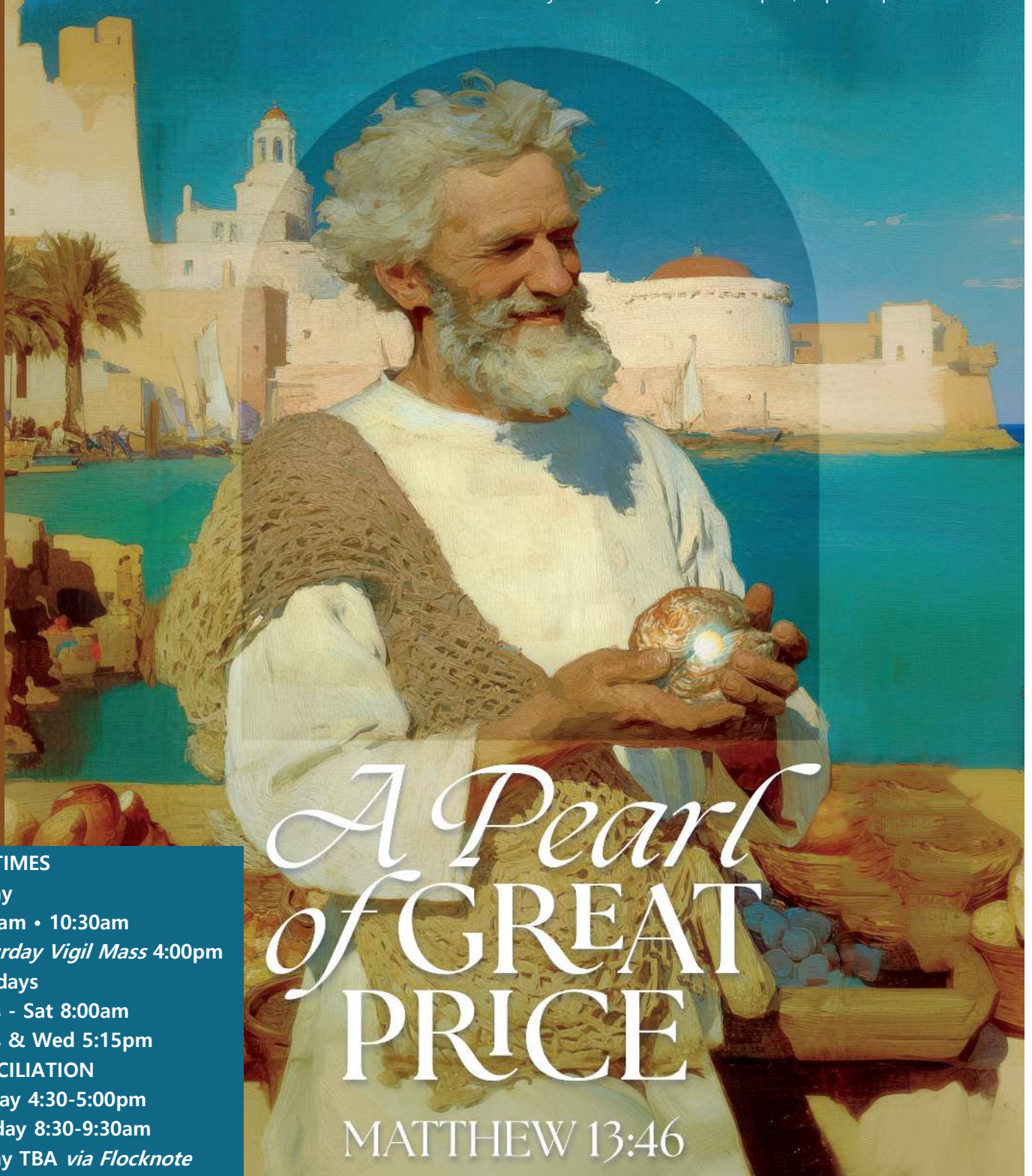

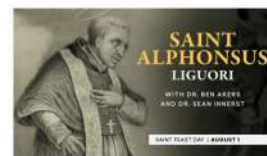
The Violinist: Stories of Solanus Casey

St. Alphonsus Liguori | Catholic Saints

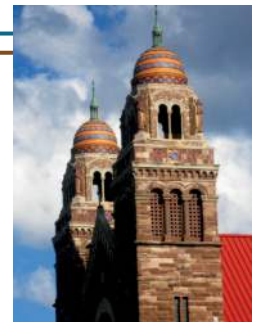

VENERABLE FREDERIC BARAGA

First Bishop of Marquette

From this journey I returned half sick and exhausted, because it was a difficult circuitous journey through all our missions among the Ottawa Indians. In these missions one must either go from one mission to another on foot or sail on the stormy Lake Michigan in a small Indian boat, which is often connected with danger to life, and which would be even more dangerous if the Indians were not so skilled in guiding their boats. On these journeys one must also spend the night at times on the shore, and this spring the nights here were very cold.

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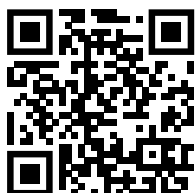
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
