



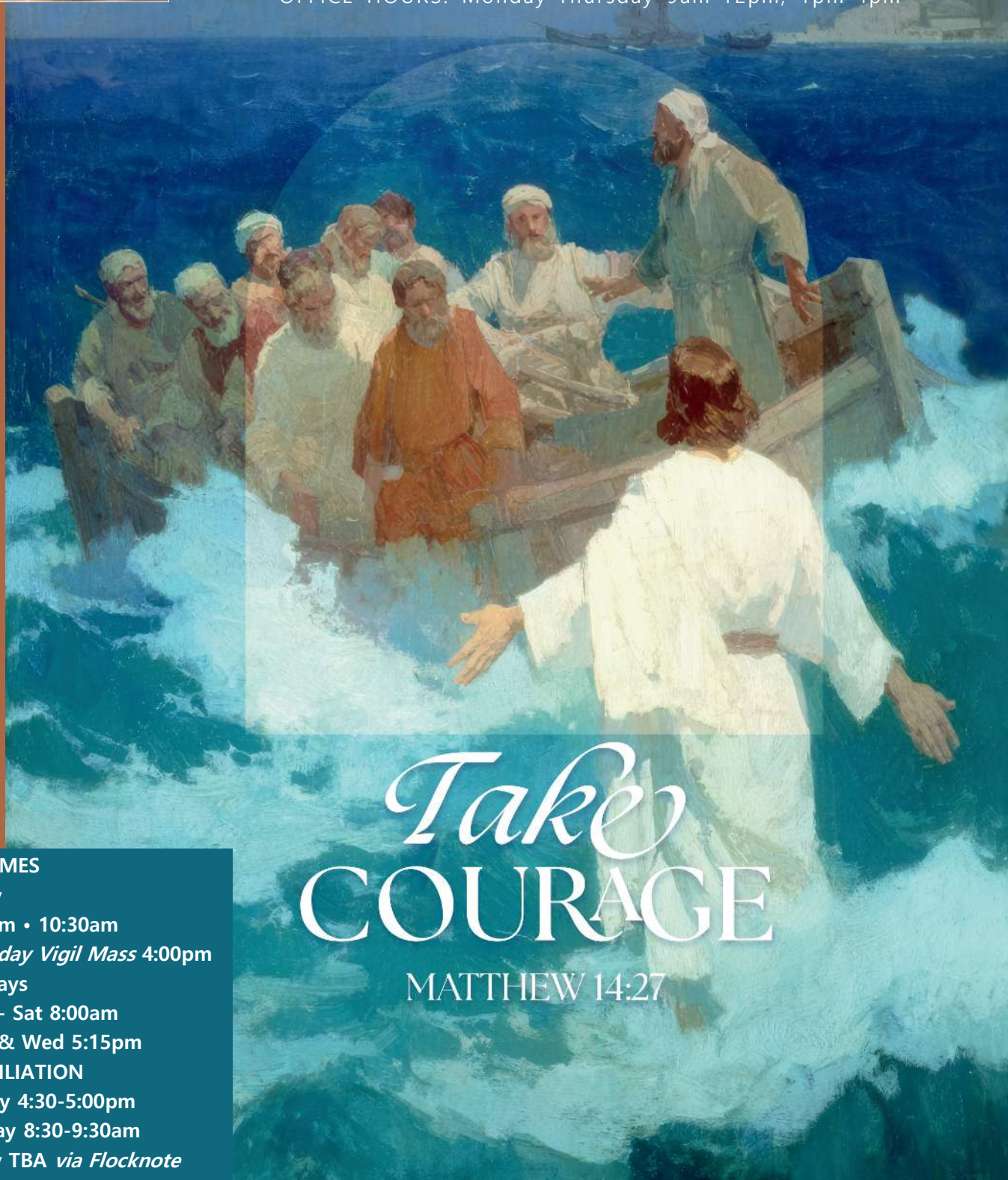

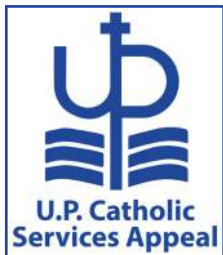

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings and Salutations! Happy 19th Sunday in Ordinary Time! In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 14:22–33), the disciples are caught in a violent storm when Jesus comes to them walking on the sea. Peter steps out of the boat in faith, but when he takes his eyes off the Lord and focuses on the wind and waves, fear overwhelms him and he begins to sink. How often that happens to us! We become consumed by illness, financial worries, family struggles, uncertainty about the future, or stuck in a rut of sin. The secret is not to pretend the storm doesn't exist, but to keep our eyes fixed on Christ. Even when Peter's faith falters, Jesus immediately reaches out His hand and saves him. St. Thérèse of Lisieux beautifully wrote, "Jesus does not demand great actions from us, but simply surrender and gratitude." Faith is trusting that Christ is with us in every storm and placing ourselves confidently into His hands.

Time flies! Aug 1st marked my two-year anniversary as your pastor. For 12 weeks, beginning sometime this Fall, I will be on a mission for the USAF. I cannot give any more details than that. Please know that you will be in good hands with Fr. Zachary and that I have been working for the last 2 years to ensure both parishes will run smoothly when I'm away.

Clare and Francis

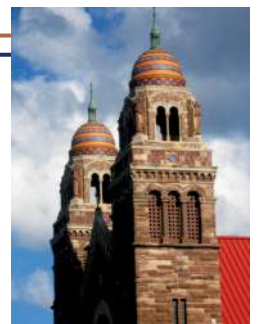
