2026-2027 Faith Formation Year

Dear Families,

I look forward to a new year of Faith Formation with you! Our classes have **three main goals**:

1. to teach students the content of their faith (for example, prayers, church teaching),
2. to help children grow in their relationship with our Lord through witness and reflection, and
3. to increase devotion to the Holy Eucharist. Grades 1-8 will attend just a few minutes of adoration in the Eucharistic chapel at every class.

We are here to **assist you** in raising and forming your children in our rich and beautiful Catholic faith, but also realize that ***you are their primary catechists***. We can see this simply in considering that we have the children for 22 hours in an entire year, and that is if they come every week! (That is only about 3 days of school.) On our own we cannot adequately form them, but we are here to serve and support you. For your child to grow, understand and embrace our faith and our Lord, will require that you live a life of faith at home, as well as attend Mass on Sundays & holy days, and participate in the sacraments appropriate to them.

Class will continue to be at **9:00-10:15 am**, so you can attend Mass at the time of your choice before or after class. Mass is the most important event you will attend with your child because it is HIS gift and makes present HIS sacrifice to us. Every month we will have **one Sunday off**, so hopefully that will make your commitment more feasible.

CALENDAR

Please refer to the **2026-2027 Faith Formation Calendar** for dates. It details the entire faith formation year which runs from September through May. It is very helpful if you place all dates on your personal calendar, making special note of the weekends and when we do NOT have a session. Sacrament Prep calendars come on a separate sheet. Both calendars are also listed on our parish website.

9:00 am MEETING PLACE!

We will continue to meet in **the Media Room at 9:00am** for **10-15 minutes** to have family catechesis, and then head over to classes. **Parents, PLEASE ATTEND with your children, as this is a time of formation for the whole family.** You will **pick children up** at 10:15am in the Gathering Area as we have done in the past.

ABSENCE FROM CLASS

Please **TEXT me, email me or call me** if you know your child will miss class. Our teachers spend much time in preparing lessons, and it is considerate to let them know if they will not have students before the day of class or **ASAP**. My cell phone number is (920)212-0269.

CURRICULUM

I will order books/workbooks on **September 14th**, the day after **registration closes**. Please submit all forms as soon as you can. A timely registration will help us receive materials on time for when class starts. IF **Textbooks WILL** come home because of family participation and follow up, please **return them the following weekend**, as we **will be using textbooks IN CLASS as well**. **Leaflets do NOT need to return.**



Grades 1

Will be a continuation of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Students will take time to contemplate their place in Salvation history as they reflect on the love of the Good Shepherd, and will practice asking how they can respond to that love. Particular projects will be emphasized with the whole group.

Grade 2

Second Grade will use GO SEEK FIND by St. Mary's Press to prepare for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion. The whole year revolves around understanding God's mercy through Reconciliation and what a gift the Mass is.

Grade 3-5

As our grades overlap, this year we are using the curriculum of **The Great Adventure Storybook, a Walk through the Catholic Bible, by Ascension**, which presents the story of Salvation in a way that engages kids' minds and hearts, and helps them understand how the Bible as a story, is fulfilled in Christ and His Church, and that they have a place in it!

Grades 6, 7-8

These 3 grades will be in one class, using the CONNECT! BRINGING FAITH TO LIFE curriculum. This is a 3 year program (we are in year 3) that will help students explore the 4 pillars of our faith: the Creed, Liturgy and Sacraments, Christian Morality and Justice and Prayer. With this program, we will be using Bibles which we have bought through a Legacy of Faith Grant last year, to develop a solid understanding and use of the Bible.

COMMUNICATION

Parent communication will mostly occur by announcement when we gather in the **MEDIA ROOM at 9:00am on Sundays**, or via **FLOCKNOTE emails**. **At least one parent should come as the first 15 minutes we meet together are a time for family catechesis, and I will often hand out something relevant to the family for the week..** Also, please check with your child each time you pick them up to see if they have anything for you. **If a class is cancelled** for inclement weather, I will most likely text you through FLOCKNOTE- it will come as a regular text. I usually text if my message is very brief.

SICKNESS

Please keep your child home if he/she feels sick, has a cough and sore throat or temperature of above 100.4 degrees.

MAGNIFIKIDS

Each child in grades 1-5 will get a **MAGNIFIKID!** issue **every month** until March. I will place them in the wooden rack on the wall next to the Bishop's Room after the last Sunday of the month and send you a text when they are ready for pick-up.
